- 1. VSLS signs within a construction speed zone shall use an Absolute Operator Speed Limit to match the VSLS sign to the construction speed zone sign.
2. The nearest VSLS sign upstream or downstream of the work zone may be affected by the work. If so, an Absolute Operator Speed Limit may be installed, setting the regular maximum speed limit of the highway.
