SUBJECT: "ROLL-UP" OR "SOFT" TEMPORARY SIGNS FOR SHORT TERM WORK ZONES

PURPOSE:

To establish a policy for the use of "roll-up" signs for short term work zones on provincial highways.

BACKGROUND:

Roll-up signs are fabricated on flexible sheeting material that allows them to be rolled-up or folded for easy storage. They are usually mounted on lightweight supports for ease of handling.

NEW POLICY:

Any roll-up sign, meeting the following criteria, is suitable for use on provincial highways for short-term work zones:

- ◆ Size, shape, colour and graphics or sign message must conform to the current edition of *Traffic Control Manual for Works on Roadways*
- ◆ Sheeting must be a minimum of "encapsulated lens" sheeting meeting CGSB Standard 62-GP-11M, Level 1 or ASTM D4956 Type III sheeting.

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
