Subject: **FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT BOUNDARY SIGNS**

Purpose:

This Technical Circular establishes a policy for the use of fire protection district boundary signs on provincial highways.

Background:

To improve accessibility of emergency information for the traveling public, the I-021 and I-022 signs (attached) were developed, defining the boundary of a fire protection district and emergency contact numbers.

Policy:

The I-021 and I-022 signs may be installed upon request of the local fire official, forest service or municipality, on highway right of way at the boundary of the district. The MoT districts will be responsible for the costs associated with sign fabrication, maintenance and installation.

In some instances installation will be carried out directly by the organization making the original request, in these cases installation costs will be at their expense. These installations would follow Ministry sign installation guidelines.
