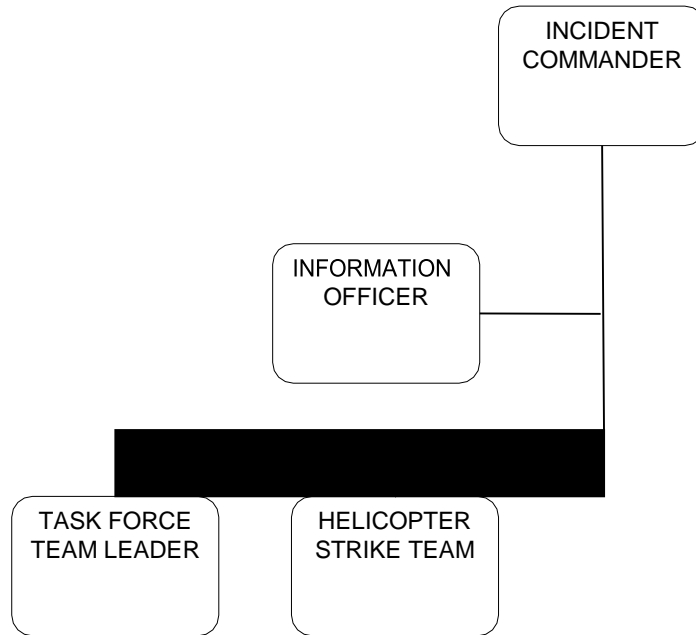

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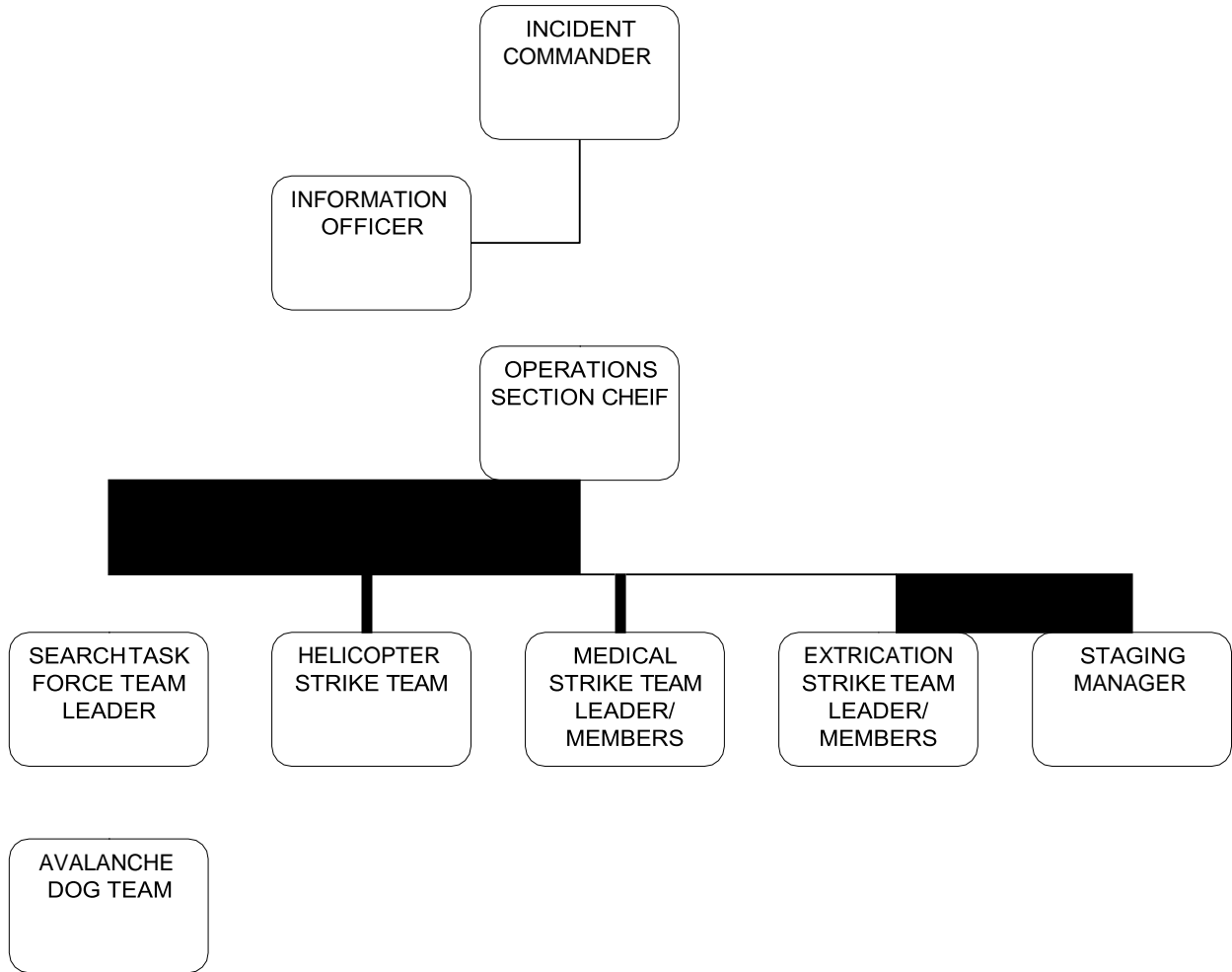



WANDING PLAN

INDICATES	<i>Colour</i>	<i>Position</i>
Safe Access/ Egress		<p>Orange.</p> <p>Indicates a route for subsequent teams to follow to access an avalanche site or as evacuation/escape route.</p>
Perimeter		<p>Yellow.</p> <p>Indicates the perimeter of the avalanche path and debris. Needed where continued snowfall may obscure path and debris.</p>
Areas Probed		<p>Red.</p> <p>Indicates areas spot-probed and the boundaries of an area covered by a probe line.</p>
Finds By Rescuers (objects, tracks & Dog Indication)		<p>Blue.</p> <p>Indicates articles or tracks inside or at the edge of the perimeter and indications made by avalanche rescue dog teams.</p>
PLS		<p>Two crossed wands, any colour.</p> <p>Indicates last seen point.</p>
Body or Live Find		<p>Three crossed wands, any colour.</p> <p>Indicates where the subject was actually found.</p>
