SA01 - LOCAL AREA SPECIFICATION #2

HOURS OF WORK RESTRICTIONS

Work will be restricted as follows, except in situations where these restrictions would be harmful to the travelling public or other Highway Users:

Highway 17, Pat Bay Highway - Swartz Bay Ferry to Tolmie Avenue; north and southbound

- No lane closures permitted from 6:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and from 3:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.; and
- No paving allowed between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. from June 15 to September 2.

Highway 1, Trans-Canada Highway (Victoria) - Tolmie Avenue to south end of 4-lanes on Malahat Drive (Tunnel Hill); includes all interchanges; north and southbound

- No lane closures permitted from 6:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and from 3:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.; and
- No paving allowed between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. from June 15 to September 2.

Highway 1, Trans-Canada Highway (Duncan) - Boys Road to Beverly Street; north and southbound

- No lane closures permitted from 6:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and from 3:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.; and
- No paving allowed between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. from June 15 to September 2.

Highway 14, Veterans Memorial Parkway - Trans-Canada Highway (including interchange) to Sooke Road; north and southbound

- No lane closures permitted from 6:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and from 3:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.; and
- No paving allowed between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. from June 15 to September 2.

Highway 14, Sooke Road - west of Veterans Memorial Parkway

- Where possible, maintain two-way traffic using shoulder areas.

The Contractor must:

- notify emergency services and BC Transit of all lane closures;
- advertise closures on the local radio and in newspapers;
- use message boards on projects greater than 2 weeks).

Notes:

- Traffic control devices must not be set up during restricted hours.
- The Province may modify the above restrictions during the term in response to conditions such as changing traffic volumes, new construction or the development of a Lane Closures Manual or other changing conditions as the Ministry determines necessary.
- The Ministry Representative, at their discretion, may grant exemptions to the above hours of work restrictions for work of short duration and/or minimal disruption to the normal flow of traffic or for work that can not be practically accomplished by means of artificial lighting.
