LOCAL AREA SPECIFICATIONS

NORTHERN REGION Pavement Marking Service Area
Northern Region Local Area Specification #1 (NRLAS #1)

Hours of Work Restrictions

1. No work will be carried out during the following restrictions without written approval from the Ministry Representative:
 - (a) The Contractor is advised that work on the Highway will not be permitted during any long weekends associated with a statutory holiday, starting at 12:00 noon the day prior to the long weekend or statutory holiday and continuing until 9:00 a.m. the day following the long weekend or statutory holiday, and that traffic volumes may necessitate cessation of Highway operations prior to that time. For the purposes of this Schedule, Easter Monday will be considered a statutory holiday.
 - (b) The Contractor is advised that work on the Highway will not be permitted during peak traffic volume periods. Peak traffic volume periods in the Pavement Marking Service Area are as follows:
 - (i) Prince George area:
6:00 am to 9:00 am and 3:00 pm to 6:00 pm, Monday to Friday and 11:00 am to 4:00 pm on Saturday.
 - (ii) Fort St. John, Dawson Creek, Burns Lake, Houston, Smithers, Terrace and Prince Rupert areas:
7:30 am to 8:30 am and 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm, Monday to Friday
2. To reduce traffic congestion within the City of Prince George during the work week, the Contractor is advised to schedule pavement marking operations on Sundays during daylight hours or Monday to Thursday evenings after 6:00 pm for the following areas:
 - (i) Highway 16 from Blackwater/Sykes Road to Old Cariboo Highway;
 - (ii) Highway 97 from Sintich Road to Kelly Road;
 - (iii) Robson Area:
Marking at Tete Jaune Intersection (Highway 5 and Highway 16) will be limited to Monday through Thursday 6:30 am to 6:30 pm.
3. The Contractor will work with the Ministry Representative to schedule around periods of special events.
