Re: Highway 1 Lynn Creek Advance Works – Pile Driving

Next week on **Tuesday Oct 23rd** we are scheduled to commence pile driving on the West bank of Lynn Creek. In previous weeks we have been drilling these piles into place but now the next phase of construction will begin and the pile driving operation will generate significantly more noise than our current operation.

Previous notices stated that pile driving would begin earlier in October, but this did not occur due to equipment shortages. We apologize for any confusion. This schedule is still subject to change however we do not foresee any more significant delays.

For now, pile driving will occur during regular working hours from 7am-5pm, however in the future we will be required to perform some pile driving at night. This is a safety precaution for traffic on Highway 1. More information will be provided closer to the date of night work.

Understanding the impact pile driving will have on your neighborhood; we are making every effort to complete this work as quickly and safely as possible.
