Dear Neighbour,

Re: Utility Upgrade Work in your Neighbourhood this Spring

In the coming weeks, we will be starting important sanitary sewer upgrade work in your neighbourhood. The project is to install a new municipal sanitary sewer on Mountain Highway starting at Arborlynn and extending 200m up the hill. This is the work that was originally scheduled for last fall.

This work will begin the week of April 1, 2019 and last approximately two months.

For duration of the works, a 24/7 northbound detour of Mountain Highway will be in place. For local Mountain Highway traffic and transit buses, the northbound detour will be up Arborlynn Drive, left onto Appin Road, and left up 14th Street to re-join Mountain Highway (see map).

For all other Lynn Valley traffic and trucks, the northbound detour will be up Arborlynn Drive to 20th Street to re-join Mountain Highway.

Southbound traffic remains on Mountain Highway at all times. Work will be mostly during daytime hours, however there will be some night work required.

When the 24/7 detour is in place, the following safety measures will be in place:

- Residents on both sides of Mountain Highway will have full access to their driveways but must use the detour to get in and out (i.e. no northbound traffic permitted). Residents cannot turn uphill out of their driveways but must always drive downhill and turn left at Arborlynn Drive to use the northbound detour route.
- On-street parking will be removed on the east side of Arborlynn Drive up to Appin Road, the east side of Appin Road between Arborlynn Drive and 14th Street, both sides of 14th Street between Appin Road and Mountain Highway, and along the north side of E 20th St from Carmaria Court to Viewlynn Drive to facilitate detoured traffic movement.
- Sidewalks will remain open. For safety's sake, please obey signage and traffic control personnel.
- The northbound bus stop between Arborlynn Drive and 14th Street will be closed. The southbound bus stops will remain open. Please visit Translink.ca and search

for “Alerts and Advisories” for changes to the Coast Mountain Bus service on Mountain Highway.

- Garbage and recycling pickup on Mountain Highway will be coordinated by Lafarge. If there are any changes to these services, you will be notified by Lafarge in advance.

Once the new sewer is installed, Mountain Highway will be repaved and new line markings painted.

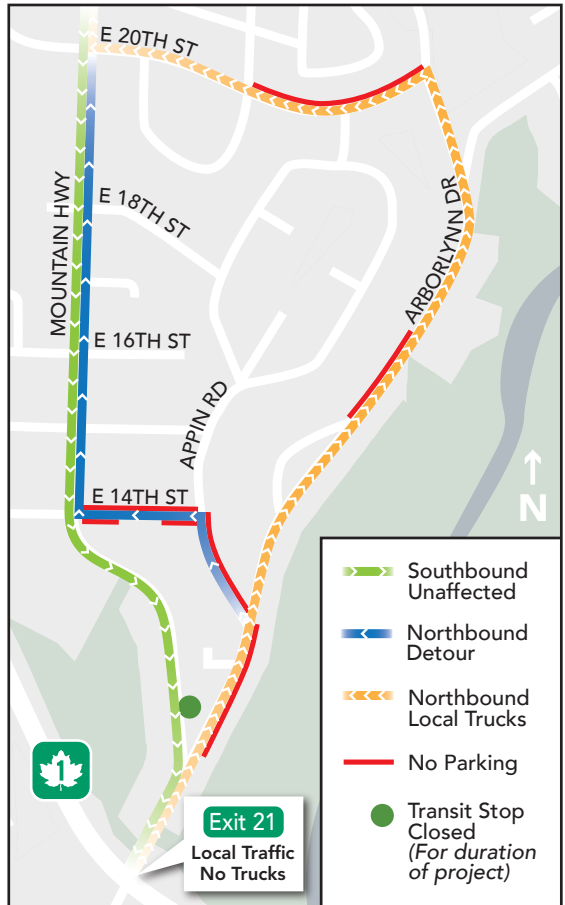
MOUNTAIN HWY DETOUR

Beginning the week of April 1, 2019 and lasting for about two months, a portion of northbound Mountain Highway will be closed 24/7 for installation of a District sanitary sewer line.

Signage on Hwy #1 will advise truck traffic to use Lynn Valley Rd for the duration of the detour.

Local traffic may use Arborlynn Dr to Appin Rd, then E 14th St to Mountain Hwy. Any local truck traffic heading north on Mountain Hwy will be routed up Arborlynn Dr.

Southbound traffic on Mountain Highway will be maintained.
