Protect yourself

Be mindful of the personal information you share when using AI tools. Don't share anything sensitive or private.

Learn about AI



Learn how AI works, including its biases and limitations. This can help you pick the right tools for you and critically think about the content AI generates.



Learn with AI, not from AI

Think of AI as a helper for your learning, not a replacement. It can assist with certain tasks, but be sure to stay involved in your learning by asking questions and getting help from teachers and other sources.

Make it your own



AI-generated content can be a starting point. It isn't a final product. Use it to spark your thinking, but make sure to add in your ideas.



Use other tools too

Don't use only AI-generated content. Use and explore different sources, resources, and tools too.

Use AI ethically



Don't use AI to cheat, plagiarize, or complete assignments for you. It's important to complete your work. Be sure to ask your teachers when you can and cannot use generative AI tools.



Be transparent

If you use an AI tool, make sure you don't misrepresent AI-generated content as your own work.

Check for bias and accuracy



AI can produce biased or wrong content. Use your critical thinking skills to think about what AI generates before using it.



Ask questions

If something seems unclear or wrong, seek clarification from your teachers or other sources you know you can trust.
