Assessment Preparation

Enrollment

Enrollments have been pre-loaded using the February 1701 data. Administrators need to check and update their online List of Enrolled Students using the Administrative Functions at <u>bced.vretta.com/#/en/bced-landing/admin</u>. They should refer to section 5.0 - How to Use the Administrative Functions of the <u>FSA Administration Manual</u> for more details.

If there are no enrollments available in the E-Assessment System (EAS), please notify the Ministry via email at <u>educ.fsascore@gov.bc.ca</u> for guidance on next step.

Assessment Materials for Schools

Materials will be shipped to schools the **second week of September** and should arrive at schools by the end of the month. Administrators need email <u>educ.fsascore@gov.bc.ca</u> if they do not receive supplies or if more supplies are required at least one week prior to administration.

Assessment Dates

Key FSA dates (Administration and Score Entry) are available on the FSA website.

E-Assessment Account Creation

Invitations to set up accounts to EAS access will be sent by our technical support team, Vretta (bced-support@vretta.com) the second week of September.

Password Letters

Log into your <u>E-Assessment Administrator Account</u> to access the password letter. The letter provides the session passwords for the administration period. This will be available during the second week of September in EAS.

FSA Technical Leads

Please connect with your district/school FSA Technical Lead to plan and manage the administration of online components.

Special Format Assessments

Large print and braille assessments are available for students at the request of their Teacher for Students with Visual Impairment (TSVI). Please email <u>educ.fsascore@gov.bc.ca</u> for more information.

Unusual Circumstances

Exceptions: All students in Grade 4 and Grade 7 must write the FSA. However, administrators can identify students eligible for exemption from one or both components of the FSA, in accordance with the specified exceptions detailed the <u>FSA Administration</u> <u>Manual.</u>

Monitoring Session

The ministry monitors district and school-based scoring of the constructed-response sections of the FSA by re-scoring a sample of student response booklets from each district and a number of independent schools in a provincial monitoring session.

Photocopied student response booklets must be sent via courier to the Ministry no later than the second week of December. Please email <u>educ.fsascore@gov.bc.ca</u> to obtain your shipping waybill.

Detailed information about the monitoring session conducted virtually in July each year, will be provided during Spring.

Assessment timing: FSA can be administered anytime between 8:00 am and 4:00 pm (local school time) during the assessment period. The assessment will take approximately 3.75 hours to complete.
