- ❖ Students are immersed in the “Level One” Carpentry curriculum where they learn the basics of constructing a wood frame structure from the bare ground to the roof top.
- ❖ Students learn both theoretical knowledge and practical application of skills and concepts related to the trade.

Saanich School District “3 Prong Vision” for any trade bound Student

1. The student satisfies graduation requirements and successfully graduates.
2. The student successfully completes “Level One” technical training.
3. The student becomes indentured as an official apprentice to a community based employer in a trade of their choice.

- The program is a district program “hosted” at Stelly’s Secondary School during the second semester of each year.
- Students should enroll in the program for two years.
- Weekly structure:
 - ✓ 20 Week Program
 - ✓ Monday to Thursday – technical training and construction of school based project in the community.
 - ✓ Friday work based training with community employer.
- Students participate in a culminating training activity at Camosun College for 7 weeks in the summer of their graduating year. Tuition for this component will be paid by Saanich School District 63.
