

# Program Overview

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- ❖ While students are taking the Joinery and Cabinet Making courses at their high school they acquire the requisite skills to be successful in the more comprehensive program offered at Camosun College.
- ❖ Students learn both theoretical knowledge and practical application of skills and concepts related to the trade.

### The Saanich School District "3 Prong Vision" for any trade bound Student

1. The student satisfies graduation requirements and successfully graduates.
2. The student successfully completes "Level One" technical training.
3. The student becomes indentured as an official apprentice to a community based employer in a trade of their choice.

## Program Details

- The program is a district program "hosted" by both Stelly's and Parkland Secondary Schools.
- Students should take a concentration of Joinery and Cabinet Making beginning in Grade 10-12.
- Students should also take Drafting as it is the "language of visual communication" in Joinery and Cabinet Making. This is essential to the understanding of theoretical concepts in this trade.
- Joinery, Cabinet Making and Drafting courses can be scheduled into the regular timetable as other course requirements permit.
- Students should be working part time in this trade while attending school to get the necessary work based training experience and hours.

Students must select a minimum of 3 of the above courses during their grade 11 and 12 year.

Students progress to Camosun College and attend night school during the spring session, and follow up with a 4 week intensive course in August of their senior year. Tuition for the Camosun component is paid for by School District 63.

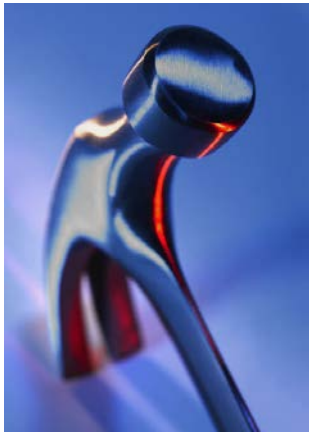

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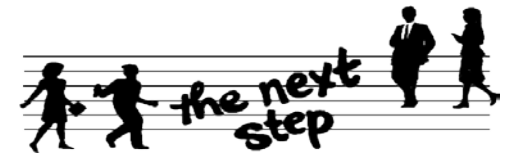
