

# MAY DATA COLLECTION

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR DISTRICT LEVEL 1701 VERIFICATION WEB REPORTS

When districts load their school 1701 files into the verification web, the files are automatically verified and a number of school level reports and files are produced. Those reports and files are described in the “Instructions for School Level 1701 Verification Web Reports” document. District level reports are produced using the verification web but must be initiated by the district contact they are not automatically produced when school files are loaded. The set of district verification reports and accompanying files allow district contacts to review their 1701 data at a summary level. If you have more than one school involved in the May data collection you may wish to produce the District Level reports. There is one zipped file containing a complete set of district reports that can be saved to your local computer or unzipped online for review. Along with this zipped file there are 15 separate verification reports saved in pdf format and two excel files. This document describes each report and file in detail.

### **Report 8033 Headcount for Schools Funded Within the F.A.S.**

This report lists headcount enrolment in schools that are funded within the Funding Allocation system.

### **Report 8035 Grade Enrolment Verification**

This report uses the headcount Eligible for Funding and calculates the conversion to funded FTE. Headcount for home school registrations are also reported.

Kindergarten-full day students are funded at 1.0 FTE, regardless of age, as long as the student is at least of school age.

A Kindergarten-full day student reported in Special Education, ELL (\*ALA) and Indigenous Education programs will be displayed in Special Education on this report (for the purpose of calculating the funded enrolment for the student).

A Kindergarten-full day student reported in both ELL (\*ALA) and Indigenous Education programs will be displayed in ELL on this report (for the purpose of calculating the funded enrolment for the student). The student will be recognized in all reported programs for program enrolment.

A Kindergarten-full day student not reported in Special Education, ELL (\*ALA) or Indigenous Education programs will be displayed in OTHER on this report (for the purpose of calculating the funded enrolment for the student).

School-age students in grade 1 through 7 and elementary ungraded (EU) are counted as 1.0 FTE.

Students in grades 8 through 12, secondary ungraded (SU) and graduated adult (GA) are converted as follows:

- For school-aged non graduated students reported in grades 8 and 9, the number of courses leading to graduation plus .5 FTE base will be used to calculate the FTE to a maximum of 1.0000 FTE per student.
- For students in grades 10-12, SU and GA, the number of courses leading to graduation will be used to calculate the FTE. These students are funded at 0.125 FTE per course.

“Total school-age students eligible for funding” is the total school-age FTE that will be recognized for funding within the funding allocation system.

“Maximum number of adults eligible for funding” is the maximum FTE that is eligible for funding.

Home school registrations are reported as headcount. Funding for homeschoolers is only provided in the September count.

### **Report 8035B Students not eligible for funding**

This report lists the headcount of students, by grade, by category, that do not count for funding. Students that are counted in this report are not counted in the grade enrolment verification report 9035.

The category “DL K-9 student not new to school” applies to K-9 students who were reported in previous collections during the school year. As K-9 students in OL schools only count for funding the first time they are reported in the OL school during a single school year, the students are summarized in this category for all subsequent data collections for that school year.

The category “DL 10-12, SU, GA, no new courses” applies to OL 10, 11, 12, SU and GA students who have reported no new courses leading to graduation since the last data collection. In the case of OL 10-12, SU and GA students, only new active courses are funded in each collection. If the student continues to be actively enrolled but has no new courses to be reported, schools are to still report the student but indicate zero courses leading to graduation. These students are summarized in this category until they are reported with a new active course or until a 24 month period has elapsed since the last “new active course”. When that occurs the student is listed as being either a “secondary student with no courses” or an “adult non-grad with no courses” and is considered “in error”.

The category “Other” can include students who have an invalid grade code.

### **Report 8035C Funded Enrolment For Schools Funded Within the F.A.S.**

This report lists funded FTE by grade grouping for schools funded in the Funding Allocation system.

### **Report 8037 FTE by Grade within School (CSV file)**

This is an excel file listing your district FTE by grade within school.

### **Report 8040 and 8040B District Language Enrolment Verification**

This report is divided into two parts. The first part 8040 indicates the headcount, percentage of time taught in French, and the resulting FTE by grade, by French language program for school-aged students. The second part 8040B reports the same information for adult students. In both parts FTE is calculated using the minimum percentage of time taught in these languages and reported headcount enrolment. Headcount data are also provided for English Language Learning (\*ALA) for students enrolled in Conseil scolaire francophone de la Colombie-Britannique). Enrolment is separated into two categories: *year 1 – 5* and *year 6+* in the ELL program.

**\$ NOTE:** Funding for these programs is only provided in the September count. Only students with a fundable FTE will appear on this report in May.

### **Report 8051 District Language Enrolment by School**

This report indicates the headcount enrolment, by school and grade, in each language program.

**! NOTE:** Only students with a fundable FTE will appear on this report in May.

### **Report 8060 District Indigenous Education Enrolment Verification**

This report is divided into two sections – school-aged students and adult students. The first line of each section indicates the reported headcount enrolment of students of Indigenous ancestry. These students may or may not be enrolled in an Indigenous Education program.

The balance of each section indicates headcount enrolment in each of the three Indigenous Education programs. For each program, two separate lines of information are provided:

- total enrolment in the program
- the subset of the enrolment who are of Indigenous ancestry.

The totals provided at the bottom of each section indicate the number of students enrolled in one or more Indigenous Education program, and the number of those students who are of Indigenous ancestry. If a student is enrolled in more than one Indigenous Education program, the student is counted only once in each of these two rows of information.

**\$ NOTE:** Funding for these programs is only provided in the September count. Only students with a fundable FTE will appear on this report in May.

### **Report 8063 District Indigenous Education Enrolment By School**

This report lists the number of students of Indigenous ancestry enrolled in one or more Indigenous Education program by school and by grade.

! **NOTE:** Only students with a fundable FTE will appear on this report in May.

### **Report 8065 District Band/Student Verification**

This report lists the students indicated as " Ordinarily Resident on Reserv" by band and school. Headcount and FTE by band are also included. This report should include all students listed on the signed off Nominal Roll for your district.

### **Report 8080 Career Program Enrolment Verification**

This report lists the enrolment by school, program and grade in a Career Program. School-aged and Adult headcount are reported separately. There is a separate column indicating fee payer enrolment in a Career Program.

! **NOTE:** Only students with a fundable FTE will appear on this report in May.

### **Report 8097 Feepayers by School**

This report lists, by school, those students who have been reported as Out-of-Province/International. The report includes the PEN, student usual name, grade and enrolled programs. This report is intended to help districts reconcile headcount and FTE information as well as special program enrolment.

### **Report 8141 Special Education Enrolment - School Age VS Adult**

This report divides the current Special Education enrolment reported on Form 1701 into school-aged and adult enrolment.

! **NOTE:** Graduated adults are not included in this report.

\$ **NOTE:** Only students with a fundable FTE will appear on this report in May. No supplemental funding is provided in the May count.

### **Report 8155 Special Education Summary by School**

This report lists summary enrolment data by school and special education program category. An asterisk indicates adults have been reported in this program category.

! **NOTE:** Graduated adults are not included in this report.

## **Report 8160 District School Error Summary**

This report summarizes the warning and error messages issued for the data submitted by schools in your district.

## **Report 8200 All Student Details (CSV file)**

This file contains all student details by school and student. With this file districts can sort by any data value. We have included columns detailing graduates, years in ELL, and FTE.
