2. Please give a brief description of new initiatives implemented by school districts for French second language programs.

- Delta took part in the Spring 2010 Lower Mainland DELF (Diplôme d'études en langue française) Scolaire Pilot in conjunction with BCTF, French Programs Branch and the Ministry of Education. DELF exams assess students' skills in French (written comprehension, written production, listening comprehension, spoken production, and spoken interaction), and provide successful candidates with an internationally-recognized certificate.

3. Please give a brief description of planned expenditures by school districts for carried over federal funds for school year 2010/2011.

Delta will continue to partner with the Surrey DELF centre to provide our French Immersion and Core French secondary students the opportunity to participate in DELF exams. Financial support will be provided for two French Immersion teachers to attend the DELF Training Summer Institute, giving Delta a total of four teachers trained as DELF examiners. Two of the teachers will develop PowerPoint presentations for use during DELF information sessions with students, teachers, administration, and parents. Delta secondary schools will be provided with resources (e.g., CLÉ International “*DELF Scolaire B1, 200 activités*”) to support students participating in DELF exams.

Delta will be providing in-service for elementary and secondary Core French teachers on the new draft curriculum for Additional Languages (optional implementation year 2010-2011).

(Pending approval from the Assistant Superintendent) Delta will initiate a “Smart Designs in FSL” project to promote the use of SmartBoards in elementary French Immersion.
