2. Please give a brief description of new initiatives implemented by school districts for French second language programs.

1. A mentorship program for Grade 5 teachers was implemented this year providing training in the AIMS method of delivering Core French.

2. A new Intensive Grade 11 semester was developed where French Immersion students studied both Grade 11 and 12 FRAL, Grade 11 SCHM and a fourth individually directed course working on a final portfolio in French. The students also traveled to Ottawa to attend an Encounters Canada session about Vimy and Canada's coming of age. This program was very successful and will be offered again next year.

3. An increase in field trip activities accessed by all grade levels: CPF Concours Oratoire, the Festival des Écrivains at Granville Island Market, the Québec Pavillion during the Olympics, and the new French Museum of Vancouver offering in Civilisations Anciennes.

4. A new emphasis was put on the development of oral skills at the LFI grade 6 level. Out teacher was trained in the use of the AIMS language approach for this purpose.

5. Participation in the DELF training offered by BCTF in conjunction with the French embassy. One teacher traveled to Vichy, France to participate in the training with the added benefit of overall improvement in her French oral skills.
