2. Please give a brief description of new initiatives implemented by school districts for French second language programs.

With the expansion of our French Immersion program in Summerland, a significant amount of money has gone to support the resourcing of the new grade. 2009-10 brought the first Grade 10 Immersion class to Summerland Secondary School. We also, in June 2010, resourced the Grade 11 class for September 2010. Most of the other resource dollars went to maintaining or expanding existing programs (i.e. staffing, French learning assistance).
