2. Please give a brief description of new initiatives implemented by school districts for French second language programs.

Currently, 57% of Gold Trail School District's student population is of Aboriginal Ancestry.

Some of these students are Metis. Our Aboriginal Enhancement Agreement outlines our responsibility to include culturally relevant and rigorous instruction in our classroom. We used a significant portion of this money to bring in guest speakers and presenters who shared with the students about the Metis culture and the French language. Teachers were able to deepen their French instruction in the classroom by making a personal connection to many of our students cultural background.

We also used the money to update our elementary French resources to sustain meaningful French instruction and learning for elementary aged students.

3. Please give a brief description of planned expenditures by school districts for carried over federal funds for school year 2010/2011.

We currently struggle to offer French courses taught by experienced French speaking teachers. We plan to use the carried over funds to support the professional development of teachers interested in developing their skills as French language teachers and speakers.
