

2. Please give a brief description of new initiatives implemented by school districts for French second language programs.

This year our school district implemented both the DELF exam and a teacher action-research team in French immersion. The DELF exam included professional development for our teachers through training, orientation and working as co-examiners of the oral component. This exam was offered to Core French and French immersion students at the secondary level, enabling them to obtain international certification of their French language competency. At the elementary level, our district formed a district-wide research team for primary French immersion teachers. This team targeted teaching reading strategies through researching, sharing, co-planning and co-teaching between teachers across schools.

3. Please give a brief description of planned expenditures by school districts for carried over federal funds for school year 2011/2012.

It is unlikely that funds will be carried over. Should there be extra funds, these will be added the funds allocated to cultural activities, so that more events can occur where the students hear many voices speaking in French. We have found through the DELF activities that more work on oral language would benefit our students, so this will be a focus of teacher professional development and student activities in the coming year.
