2. Please give a brief description of new initiatives implemented by school districts for French second language programs.

No new initiatives were implemented for French second language programs.

Existing programs continued to be enhanced through teacher professional development activities.

Additional teaching resources were purchased to continue the development of a scope and sequence program from grade 5 through to grade 12 (Core French).

Existing course materials were supplemented with resources designed to move students toward problem and inquiry based learning. These included the purchase of math manipulatives and reference books for Socials, Science and Math. More lit circle novels were added to the language arts program.

French Immersion classes were provided with opportunities to visit and experience French language activities in community based settings. The grade 7 class traveled to Bamfield Marine Science Centre to study marine life in French, while the grade 11-12 class visited Quebec City for 3 days. Grade 6 and 8 attended French concerts and films in Victoria. All students participated in Concours Oratoire activities and in our district's Festival Francophone.
