2. Please give a brief description of new initiatives implemented by school districts for French second language programs.

Most other resource dollars went to maintaining existing programs (i.e. staffing, French learning assistance) or offering culturally relevant performances. The final phase of expansion for our French Immersion program in Summerland will occur with the addition of the first grade 12 class. As a result, a significant amount of funding has gone toward supporting the acquisition of the new required resources. Also, with the addition of a fourth grade 6 class at KVR Middle School, additional resources were purchased to accommodate the increased enrolment.
