

topics, which will include a plan for co-ordinated teacher inservice, priorities for purchasing more resources especially for Immersion Growth, as well as an increased focus on cultural activities that enhance the French Immersion Program.

- Teacher inservice topics identified include collaborative curriculum development, Instructional Learning Rounds, Assessment for Learning and use of Performance Standards in French Immersion.
- Fund teacher participation in provincial DELF training and in attendance at ACPI National Conference in Victoria.
- Use funds to supplement curriculum implementation literacy resources.
