2. Please give a brief description of new initiatives implemented by school districts for French second language programs.

The school district has supported teachers of French as a Second Language in the earlier primary grades (1 to 4) by providing workshop sessions (4 times in the 2010/2011 calendar year). These teachers acquired French language and activities to bring back to their primary classrooms. They also received resources to support them with their French programs. These sessions are offered by proficient French teachers in the district. The school district is continuing this support in the 2011/2012 school year.

As the new *Additional Languages Elementary-Secondary Curriculum 2010* is to be implemented in September 2013, teachers of grades 5 to 12 will receive collaborative work sessions to familiarize themselves with the new curriculum. These sessions will support proficient and non-proficient teachers in their FSL programs. Teachers will be comparing resources and collaborating with other teachers in the school district to develop an FSL program for their classrooms. These sessions will be offered by proficient French teachers in the district.

Our school district has also accepted to participate in the Field Trial of the *Additional Languages Elementary-Secondary Curriculum 2010* in the 2011/2012 school year.

Teachers from grades 5 to 12 participating in the Field Trial will receive extra support time to collaborate and plan for their classrooms.

The school district sent 2 teachers to get certified in the DELF training. They will continue to support new teachers for this training.

3. Please give a brief description of planned expenditures by school districts for carried over federal funds for school year 2011/2012.

In the 2011/2012 school year, the carried over funds will be used in their specific areas. The E-Learning grant will be spent by educating new staff on e-learning as well as purchasing peripheral devices and other on-line learning resources for the French Immersion programs.

The Teacher Pro-D grant will be used to continue to support the FSL teachers with the introduction of French in the lower primary grades (1 to 4) by offering French sessions and workshops as well as for the teachers of grades 5 to 12. Teachers are also encouraged to use this grant to work on their French proficiency.

The Core French grant will be used to purchase learning resources for the grades 1 to 12 classrooms. Teachers from grades 1 to 4 will receive resources to continue the promotion of French in their primary classrooms. In the grades 5 to 7, posters and other motivational resources will be purchased as well as upgraded resources for grades 5 to 12.

The French Immersion grant will support the employment of French speaking assistants in French Immersion classrooms. This grant will also support the purchase of items and resources for a new K/1 FI classroom.

In order to offer greater cultural experiences to the students in both FSL and French Immersion programs from grades 1 to 12, cultural presentations will be scheduled during the school year. French Immersion schools will participate in the IDELIRE program. There is also the possibility of doing an exchange with SEVEC.
