OVERVIEW OF FUNDING RATES FOR INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS

Per full-time equivalent (FTE) student funding rates for independent schools are calculated based on public school operating grants and enrolment of the school district in which the independent school is located. The rates are determined in accordance with the [Independent School Regulation](#), section 3(4).

Preliminary per FTE rates have been determined for 2025/26 based on estimated public school enrolment as at September 29, 2025, as well as on estimated public school operating grants determined based on enrolment as at that date. These rates will be updated when actual public school enrolment is known in December 2025.

TABLE 1 PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT OPERATING GRANT SUBTOTAL TO CALCULATE THE PER FTE STUDENT GRANT FOR INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS, 2025/26 ESTIMATED

The estimated independent school per FTE student grant for 2025/26 is calculated based on estimated operating grants allocated to public school districts as at March 2025, less the special needs portion of the Supplement for Unique Student Needs, plus Provincial Learning Network, plus the Classroom Enhancement Fund. The result is the operating grant subtotal for determining the independent schools per FTE student grant.

The total of the July and September 2025 public school operating grants is the base from which the per FTE rates for independent schools are calculated. Operating grants allocated to school districts for the February and May 2025 enrolment counts are not included in the independent school per FTE rate calculation.

TABLE 2 2025/26 PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT ESTIMATED FTE STUDENTS

This table provides a summary of estimated funded FTE students in public school districts for 2025/26 as at September 29, 2025. The total of all September enrolment is used in the determination of the per FTE student grant for independent schools.

The subtotal public school operating grant from Table 2 is divided by total estimated public school FTE students from Table 3. The result is the estimated per FTE student grant for independent schools for 2025/26.

The estimated 2025/26 per FTE grants for independent schools calculated on Table 4 are used to determine estimated per FTE funding amounts for independent schools. For Group 1 schools, this is 50% of the per FTE student grant and for Group 2 schools, this is 35% of the per FTE student grant.

The amounts on Table 5 will be updated in December 2025 after actual September 29, 2025 public school enrolment is known and the public school operating grants are recalculated.

These rates do not apply to Online Learning independent schools.

OTHER PER STUDENT FUNDING RATES

The following per student rates apply to Group 1 and 2 independent schools based on per student amounts provided for public school students. These rates apply to 2025/26.
