OVERVIEW OF FUNDING RATES FOR INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS

Per full-time equivalent (FTE) student funding rates for independent schools are calculated based on public school operating grants and enrolment of the school district in which the independent school is located. The rates are determined in accordance with the [Independent School Regulation](#), section 3(4).

Preliminary per FTE rates have been determined for 2023/24 based on estimated public school enrolment as at September 29, 2023, as well as on estimated public school operating grants determined based on enrolment as at that date. These rates will be updated when actual public school enrolment is known in December 2023.

TABLE 1 PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT OPERATING GRANT SUBTOTAL TO CALCULATE THE PER FTE STUDENT GRANT FOR INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS, 2023/24

The independent school per FTE student grant for 2023/24 is calculated based on actual operating grants allocated to public school districts resulting from the September 2023 enrolment count, less the special needs portion of the Supplement for Unique Student Needs, plus Provincial Learning Network, plus the Classroom Enhancement Fund. Also included in the independent school per FTE student grant for this year is a one-time grant for labour settlement funding. The result is the operating grant subtotal for determining the independent schools per FTE student grant.

The total of the July and September 2023 public school operating grants is the base from which the per FTE rates for independent schools are calculated. Operating grants allocated to school districts for the February and May 2024 enrolment counts are not included in the independent school per FTE rate calculation.

TABLE 2 2023/24 PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT FTE STUDENTS

This table provides a summary of actual funded FTE students in public school districts for 2023/24 as at September 29, 2023. The total of all September enrolment is used in the determination of the per FTE student grant for independent schools.

The subtotal public school operating grant from Table 2 is divided by total actual public school FTE students from Table 3. The result is the per FTE student grant for independent schools for 2023/24.

TABLE 4

FOR INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS, 2023/24

The 2023/24 per FTE grants for independent schools calculated on Table 4 are used to determine the per FTE funding amounts for independent schools. For Group 1 schools, this is 50% of the per FTE student grant and for Group 2 schools, this is 35% of the per FTE student grant.

The amounts on Table 4 have been updated based on actual public school operating grants recalculated after the September 29, 2023 enrolment count.

These rates do not apply to Online Learning independent schools.

OTHER PER STUDENT FUNDING RATES

The following per student rates apply to Group 1 and 2 independent schools based on per student amounts provided for public school students. These rates apply to 2023/24.
