OVERVIEW OF FUNDING RATES FOR INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS

Per full-time equivalent (FTE) student funding rates for independent schools are calculated based on public school operating grants and enrolment of the school district in which the independent school is located. The rates are determined in accordance with the [Independent School Regulation](#), section 3(4).

Final per FTE rates have been determined for 2017/18 based on actual public school enrolment as at September 29, 2017, as well as on public school operating grants determined based on enrolment as at that date. These rates replace the estimated rates determined in March 2017.

TABLE 1 PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT OPERATING GRANT SUBTOTAL TO CALCULATE THE PER FTE STUDENT GRANT FOR INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS, 2017/18

The independent school per FTE student grant for 2017/18 is calculated based on actual operating grants allocated to public school districts based on enrolment as at September 29, 2017, less the special needs portion of the Supplement for Unique Student Needs, plus Provincial Learning Network, plus the Classroom Enhancement Fund. The result is the operating grant subtotal for determining the independent schools per FTE student grant.

The total of the July and September 2017 public school operating grants is the base from which the per FTE rates for independent schools are calculated. Operating grants allocated to school districts for the February and May 2018 enrolment counts are not included in the independent school per FTE rate calculation.

Public school grants are being adjusted for administrative savings that apply to boards of education in 2017/18. However, through a special purpose grant, these funds are being returned to boards of education in the same amounts, exactly offsetting administrative savings. As these adjustments offset one another, administrative savings has not been included in the independent school rates calculation.

TABLE 2 2017/18 PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT FTE STUDENTS

This table provides a summary of funded FTE students in public school districts for 2017/18 as at September 29, 2017. The total of all September enrolment, school-age and non-graduated adults, is used in the determination of the per FTE student grant for independent schools.

The subtotal public school operating grant from Table 2 is divided by total public school FTE students from Table 3. The result is the per FTE student grant for independent schools for 2017/18.

TABLE 4

FOR INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS, 2017/18

The 2017/18 per FTE student grants for independent schools calculated on Table 4 are used to determine per FTE funding amounts for independent schools. For Group 1 schools, this is 50% of the per FTE student grant and for Group 2 schools, this is 35% of the per FTE student grant.

These rates do not apply to Distributed Learning independent schools.

OTHER PER STUDENT FUNDING RATES

The following per student rates apply to Group 1 and 2 independent schools based on per student amounts provided for public school students. These rates apply to 2017/18.
