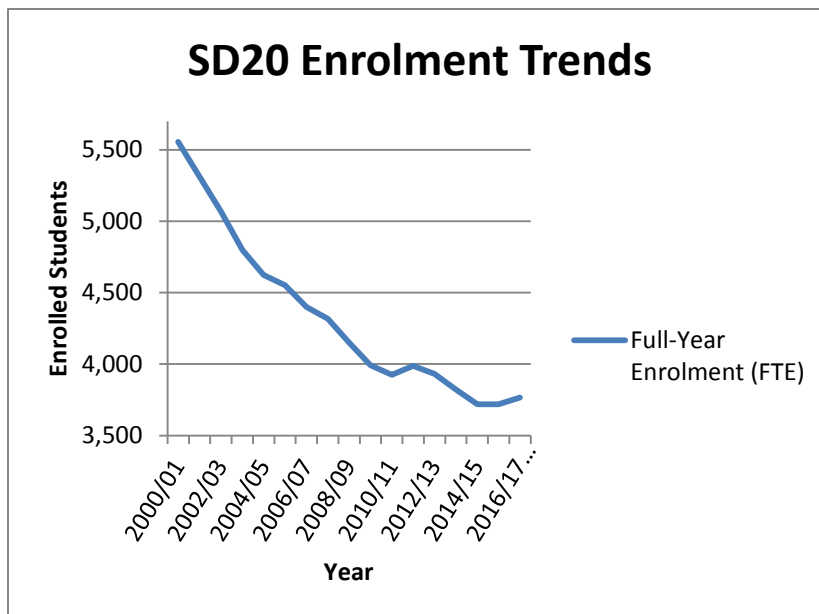
## Class Size
