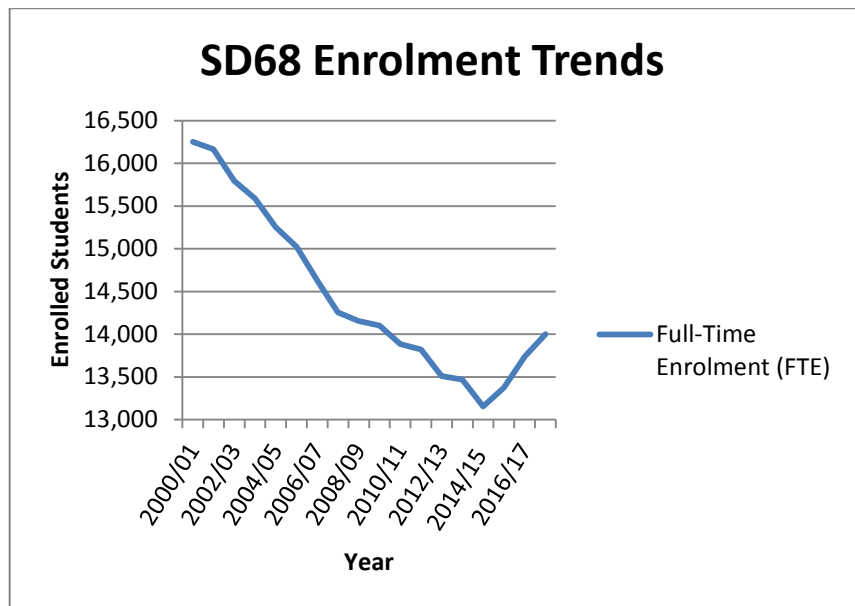
Class Size
