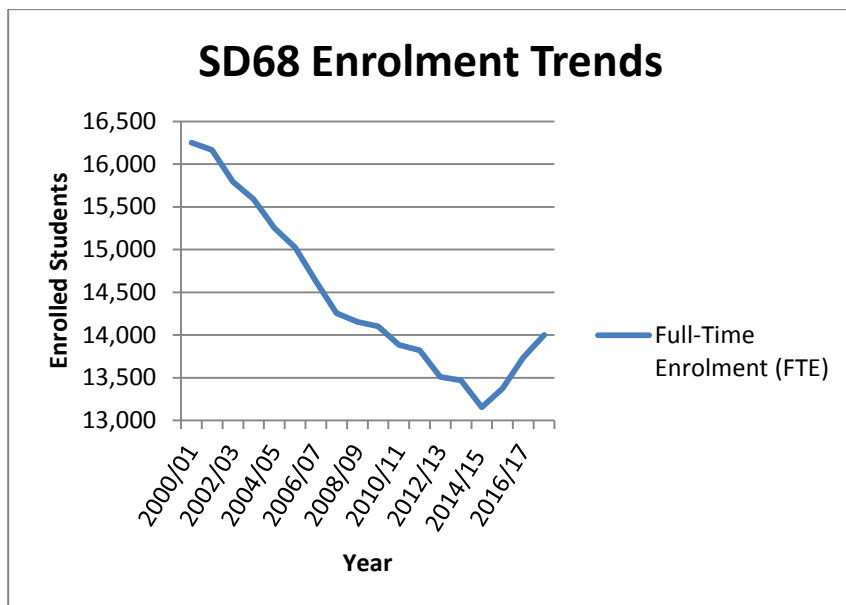
Class Size

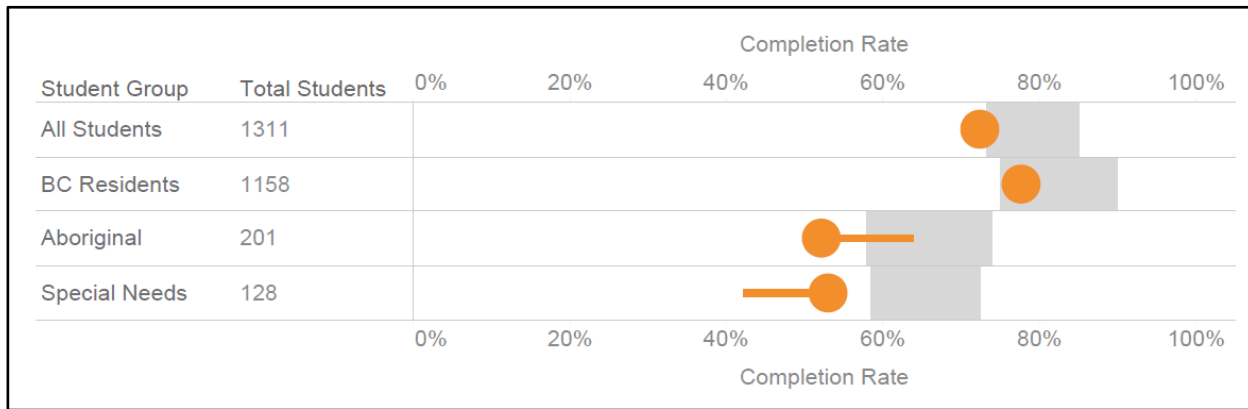

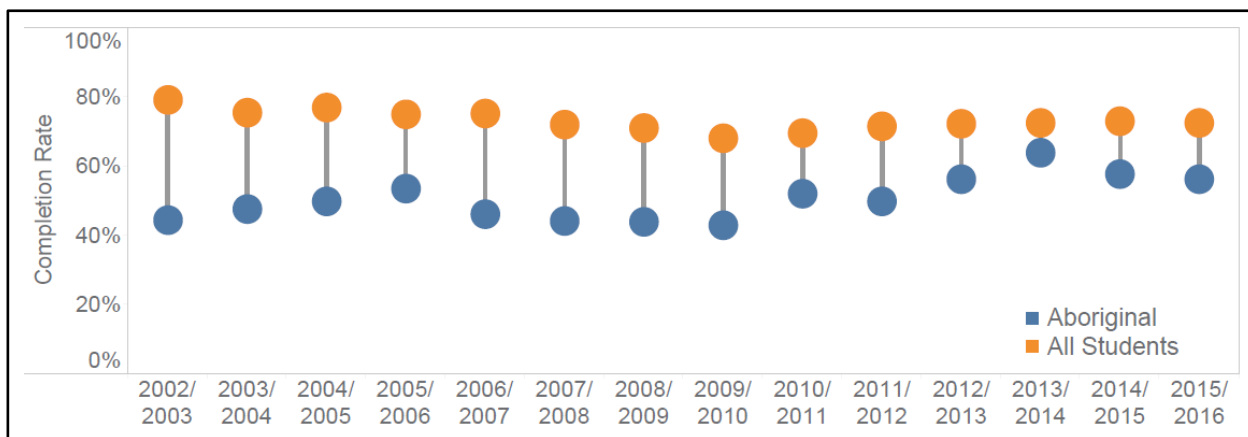
