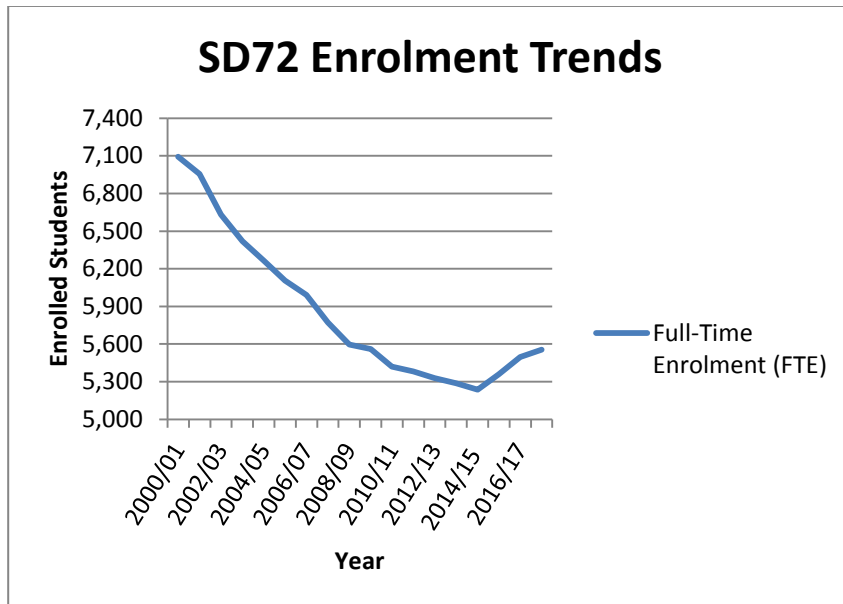
Class Size

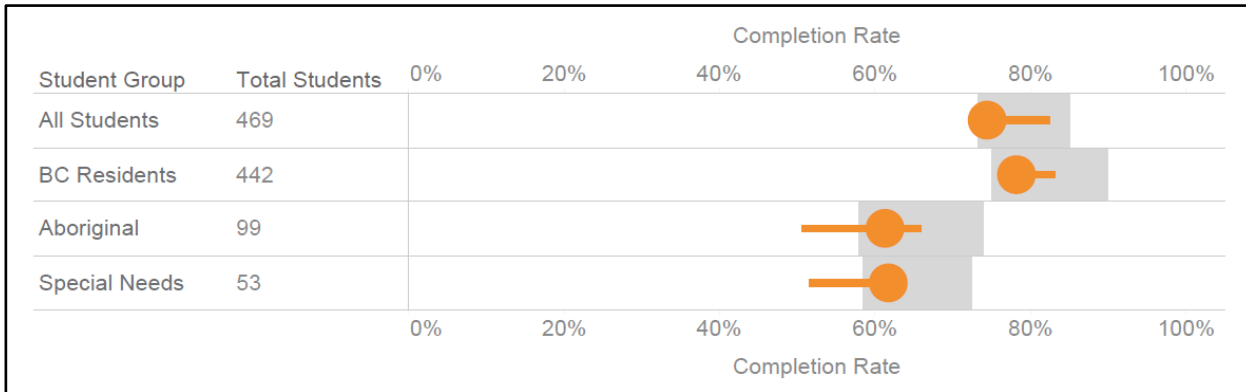

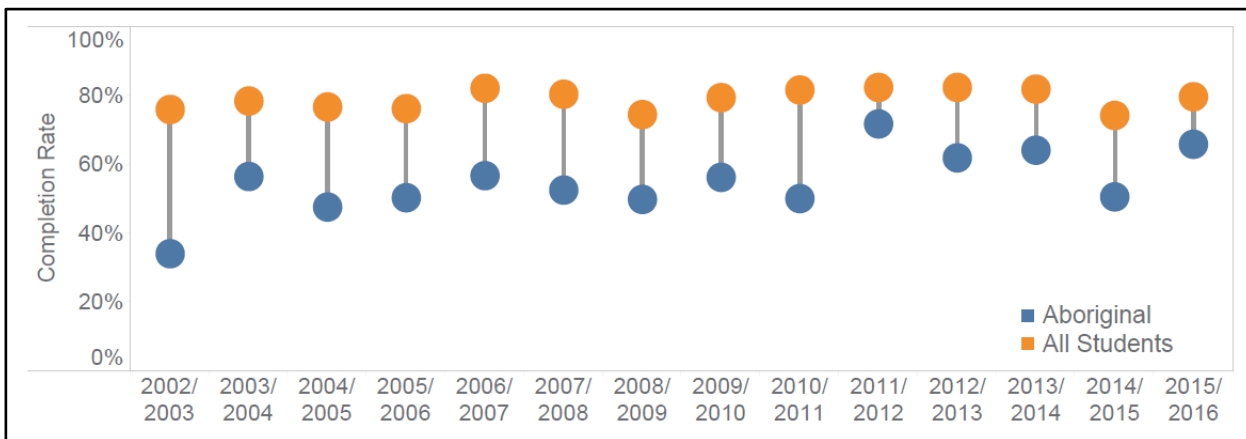
