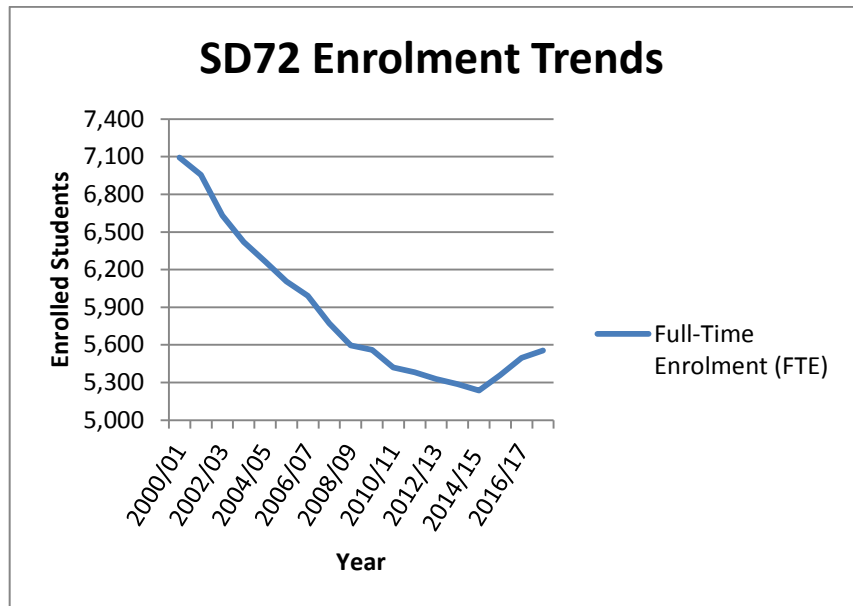
Class Size
