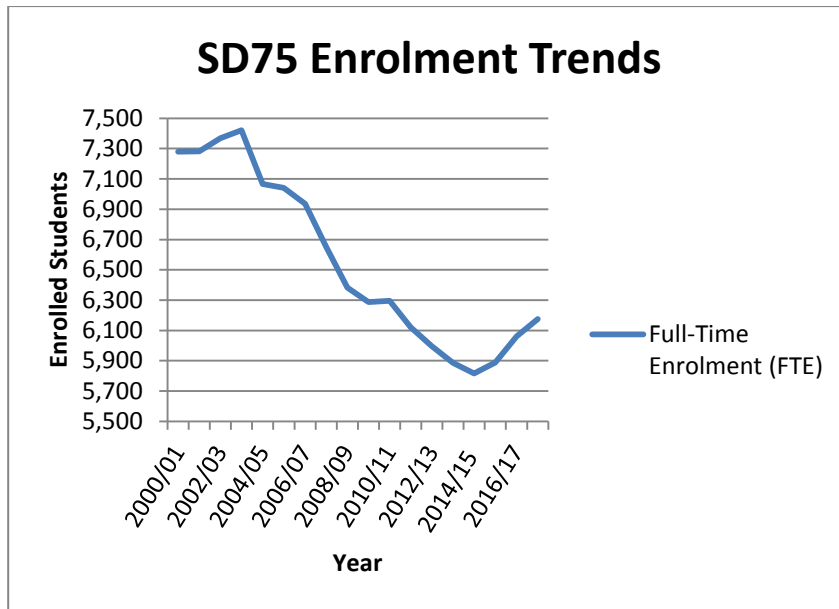
Class Size

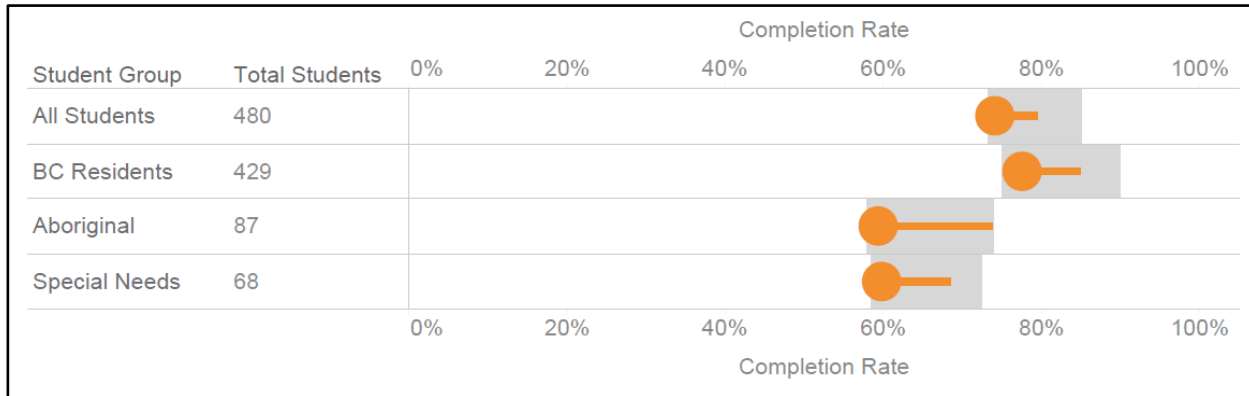

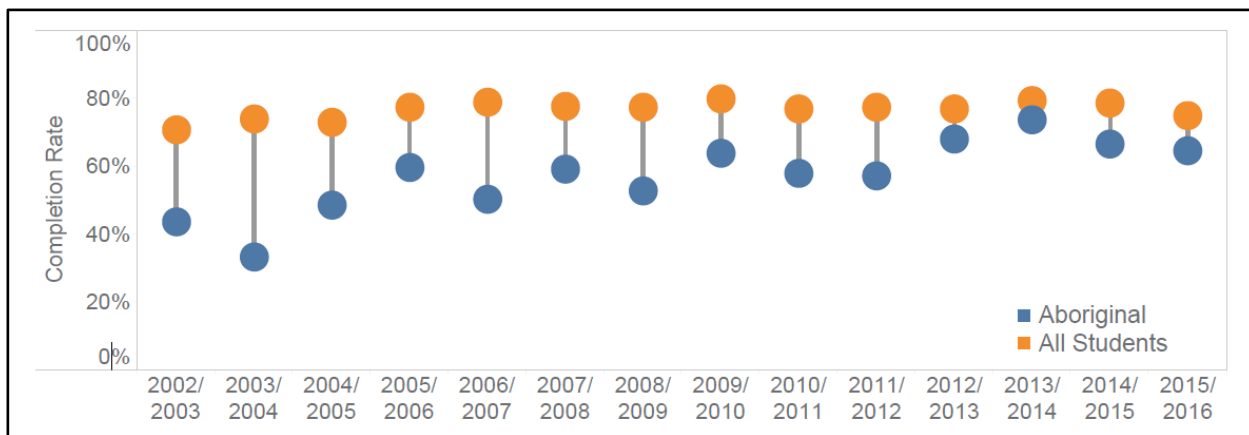
