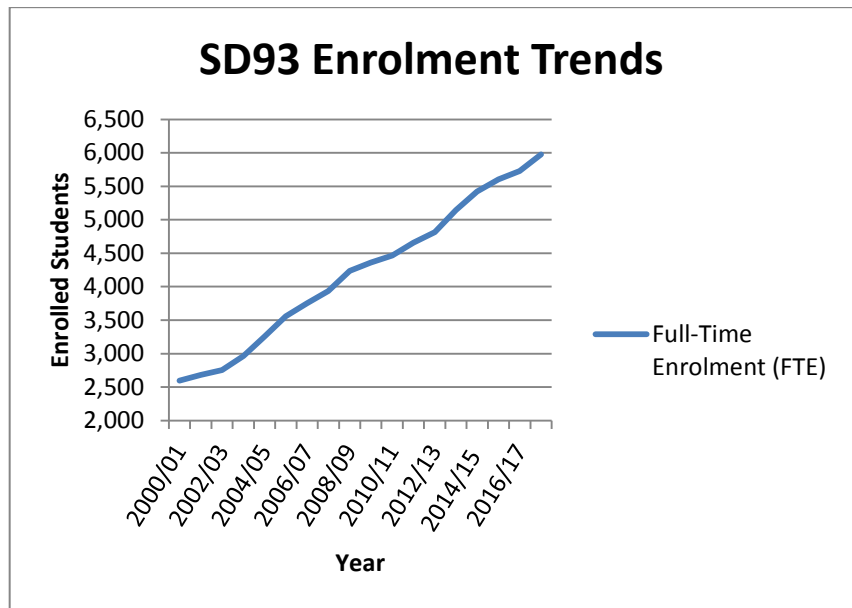
### Class Size
