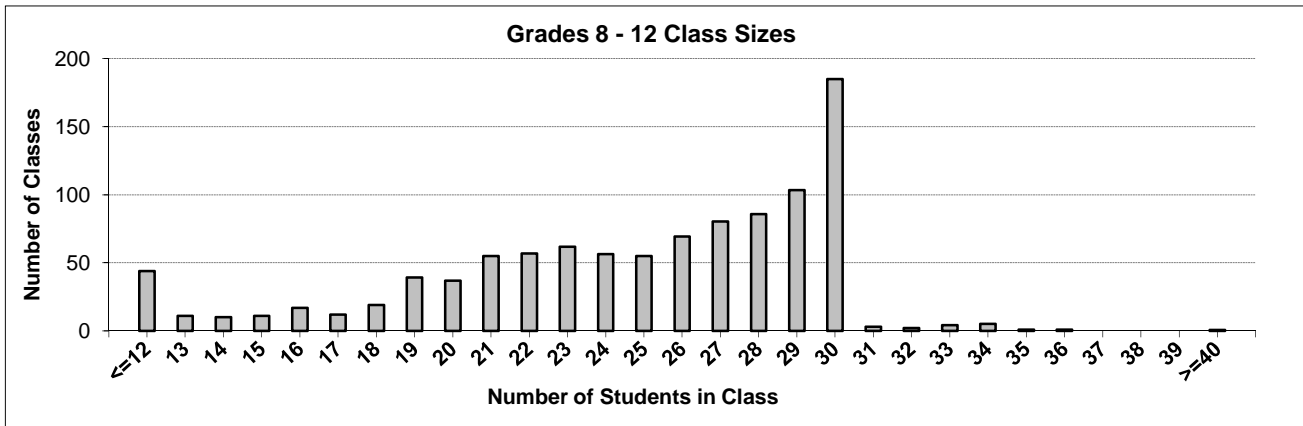

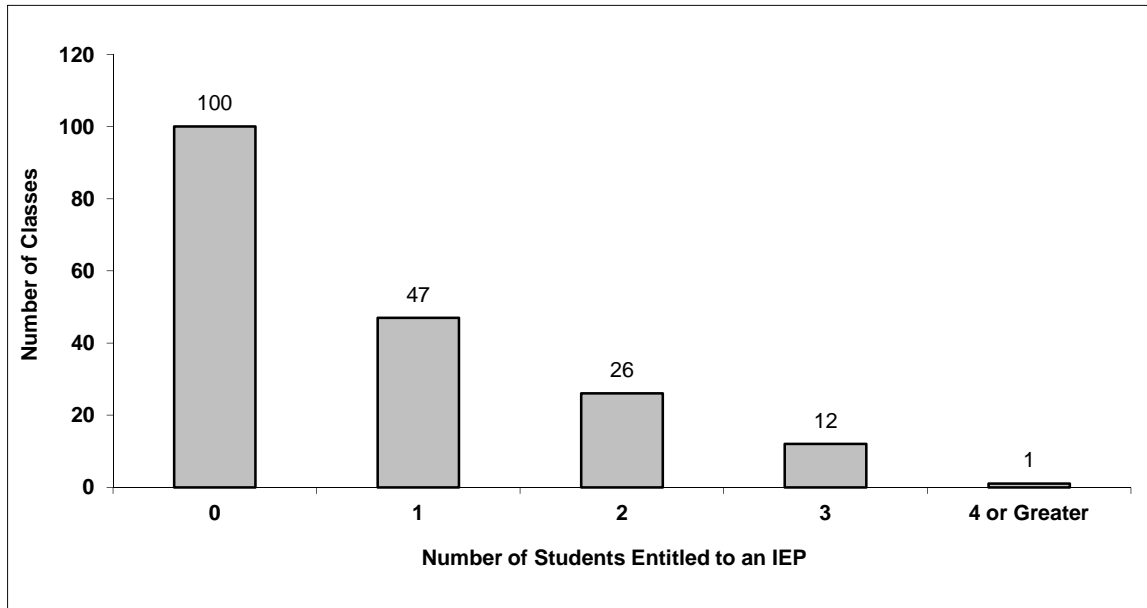

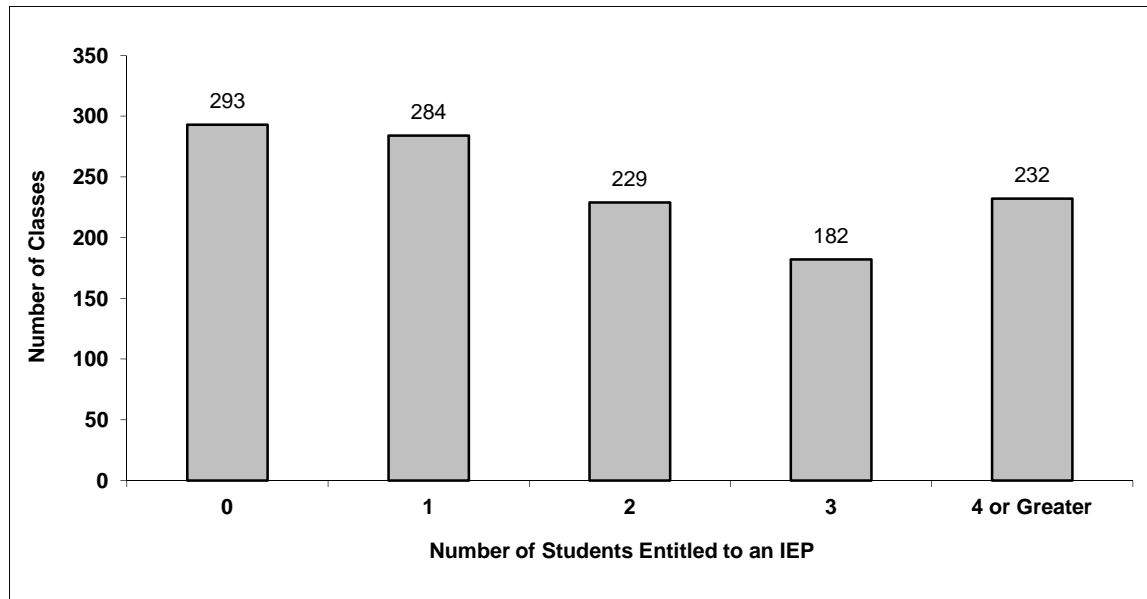

### Grades 4-12 - Number of Classes in District with 'X' Number of Students Entitled to an IEP

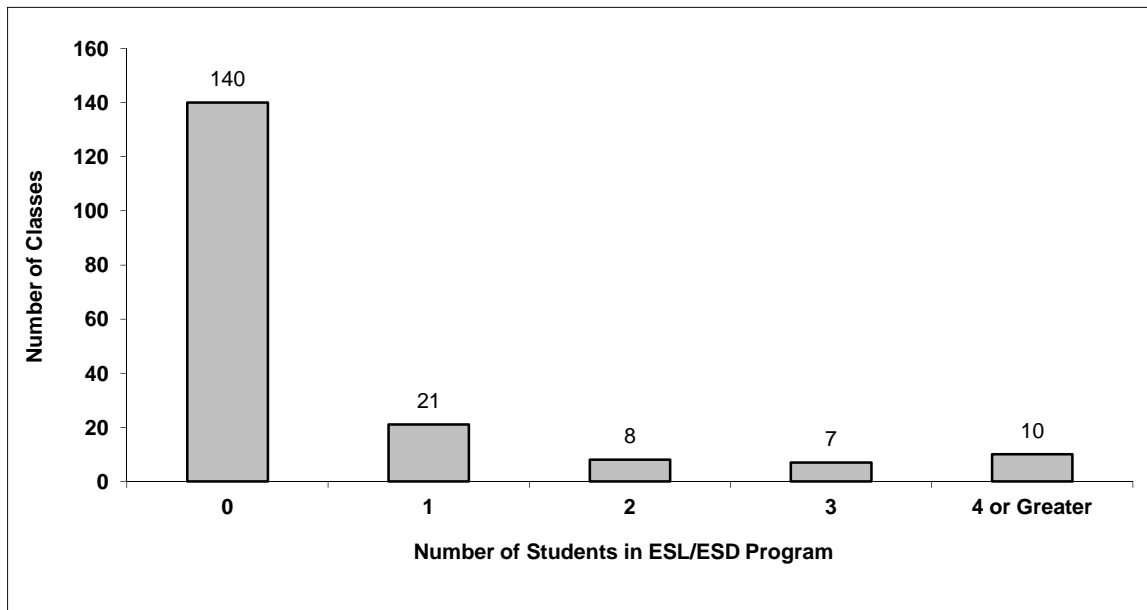

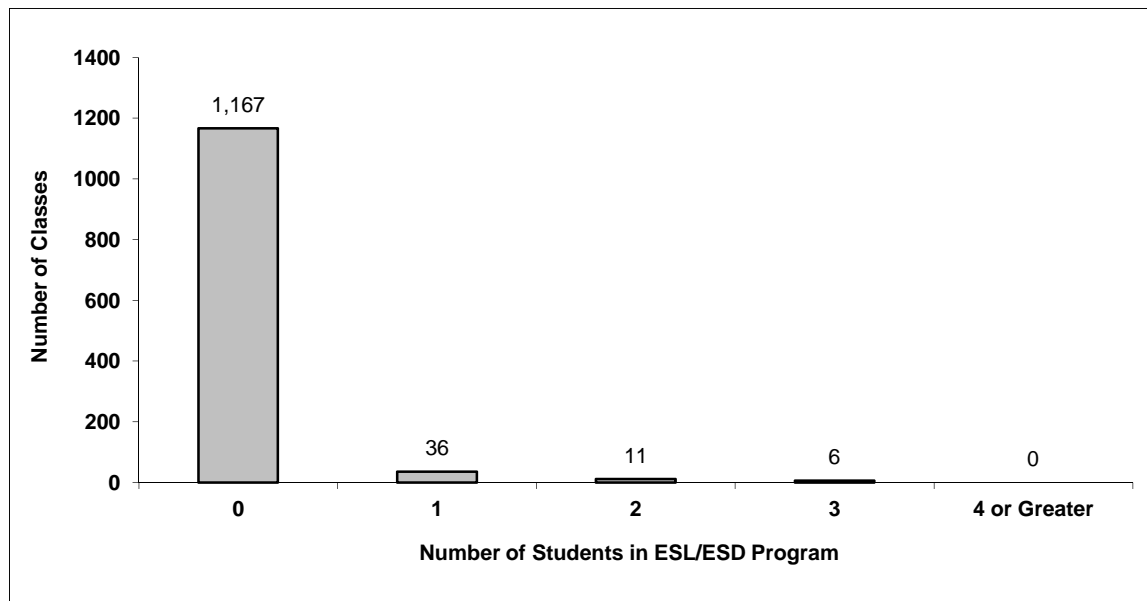

<b>Grade</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The assigned grade of a student on September 30.</li> </ul>
<b>KH</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Kindergarten half-time</li> </ul>
<b>KF</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Kindergarten full-time</li> </ul>
<b>Number of Students</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Student population is calculated by headcount.</li> </ul>
<b>Student</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A person enrolled in a BC school. Student populations are calculated by headcount. Students include all adult and school-aged persons who are working toward a certificate of graduation.</li> </ul>
<b>Student Entitled to an Individual Education Plan</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A student for whom an Individual Education Plan (IEP) must be designed under the Individual Education Plan order, Ministerial Order 638/95.</li> </ul>
