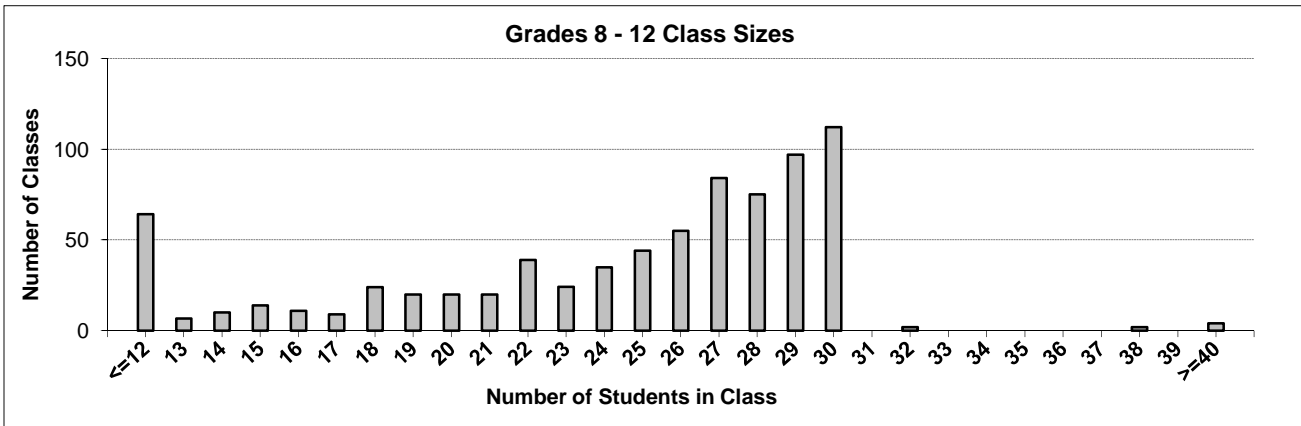
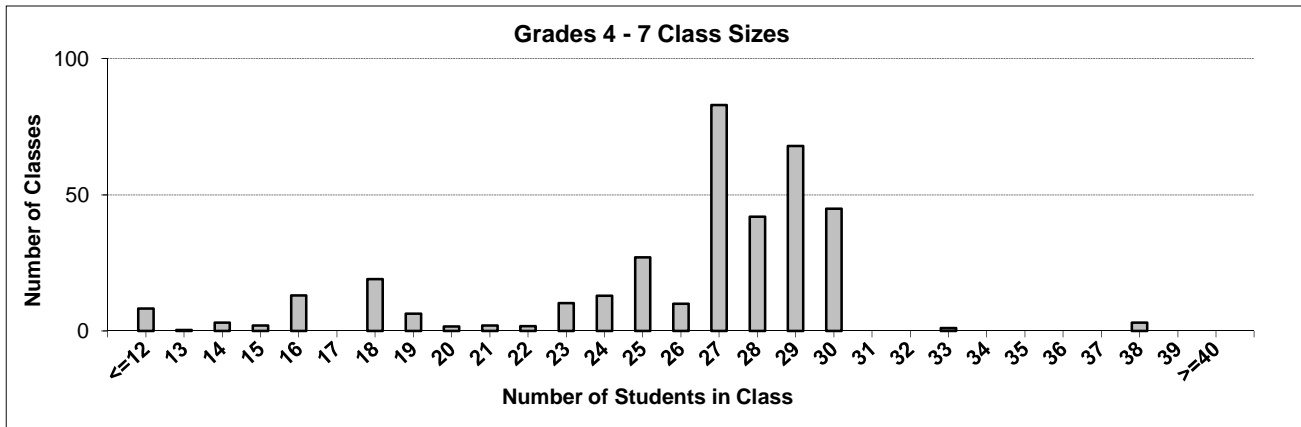
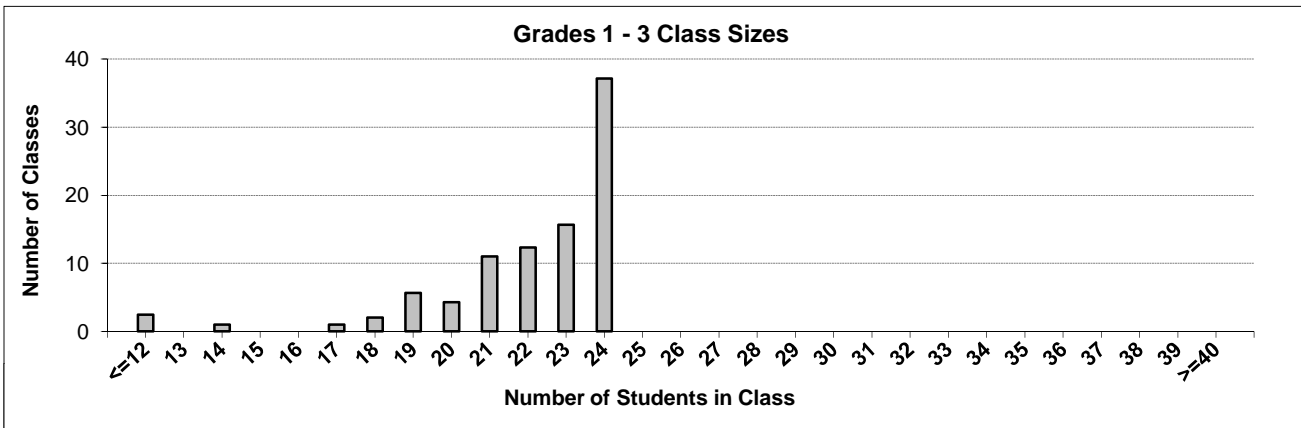
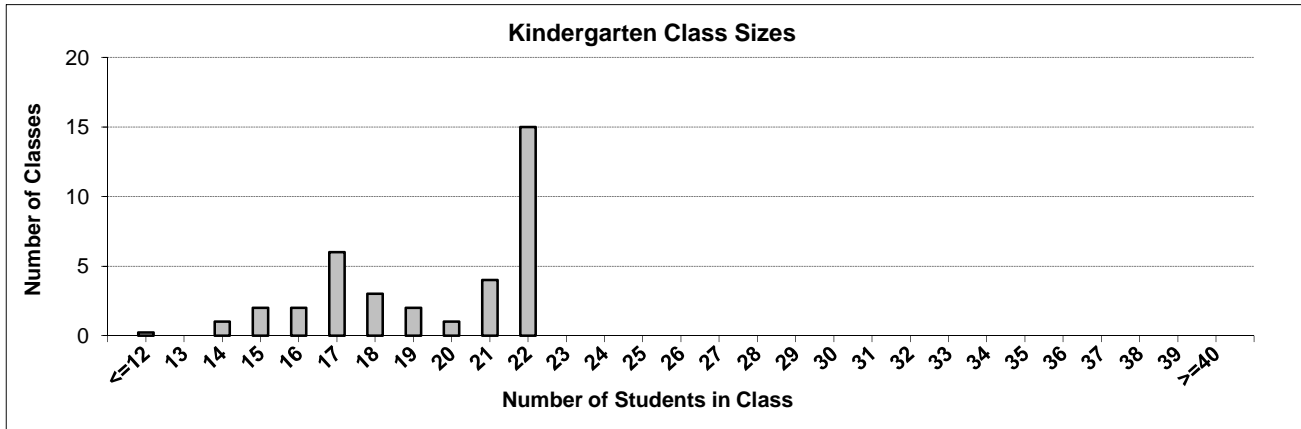

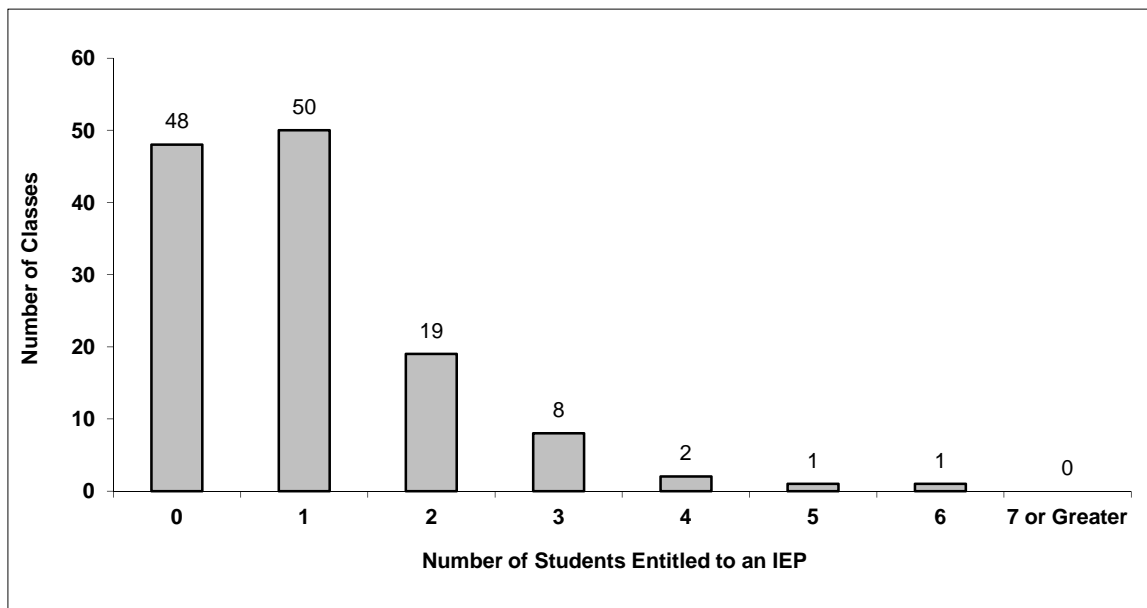

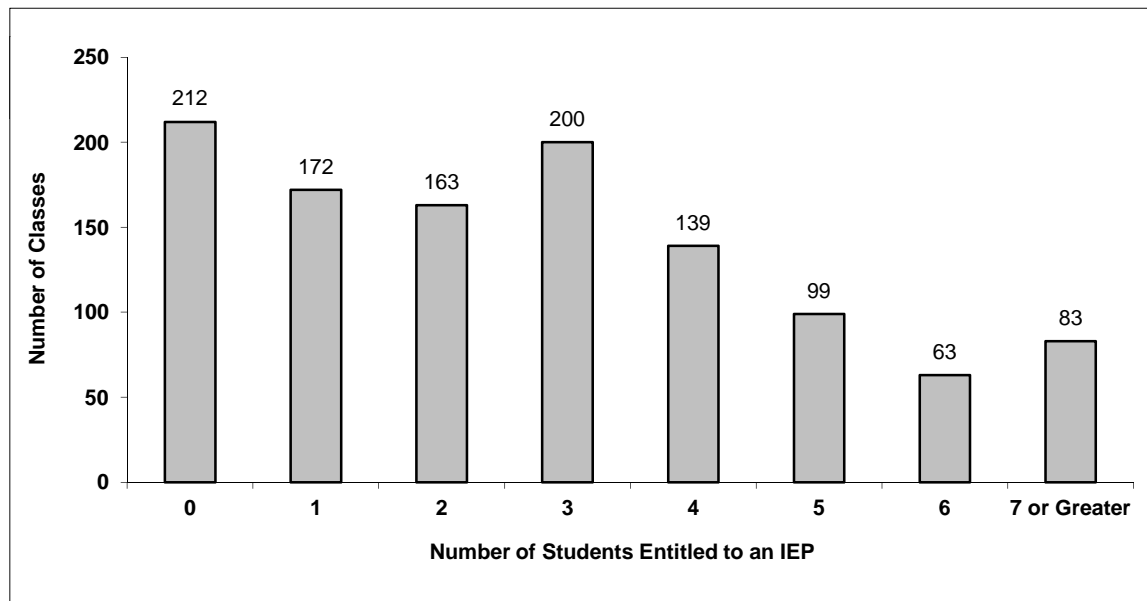

Grades 4-12 - Number of Classes in District with 'X' Number of Students Entitled to an IEP

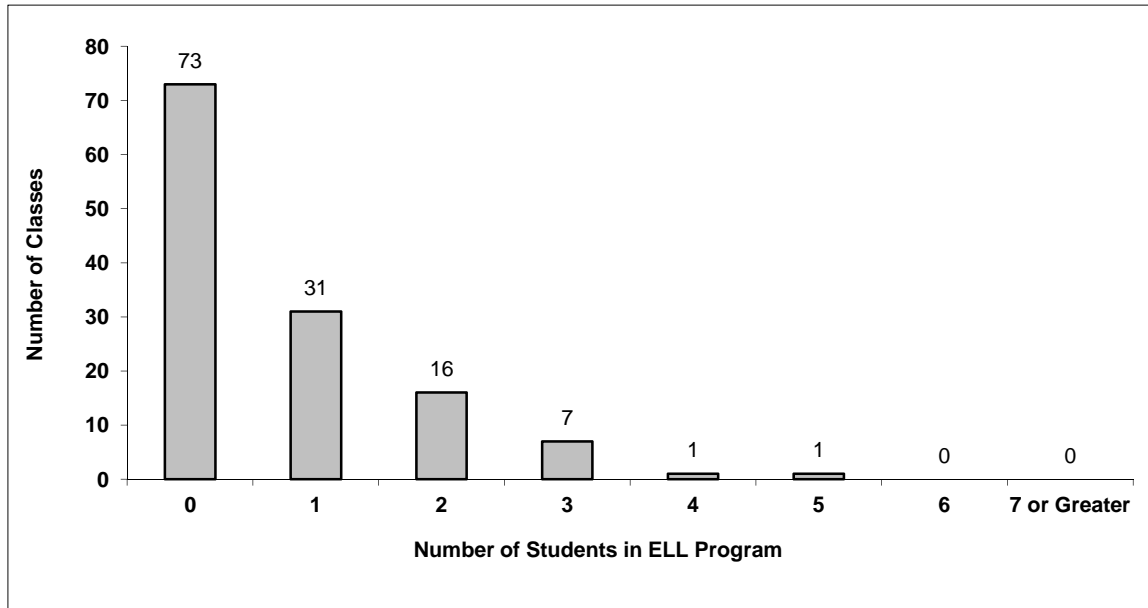

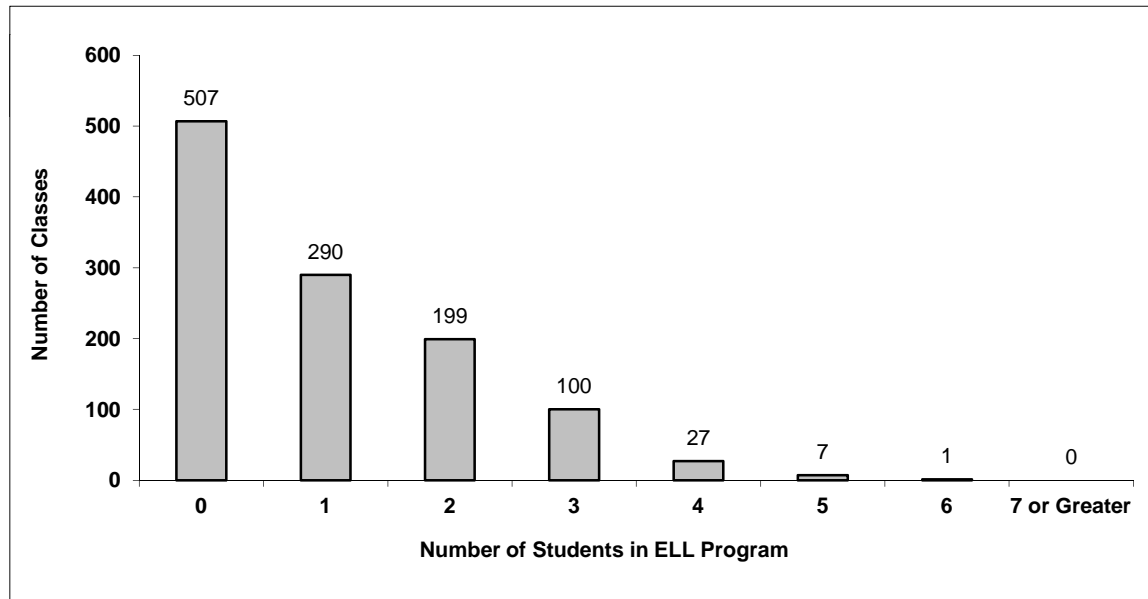

Term	Definition / Notes
English Language Learners (ELL)	• A program offered to students whose primary language(s) is/are other than English, and who may require additional services.
Grade	• The assigned grade of a student on October 15.
K	• Kindergarten
Number of Students	• Student population is calculated by headcount.
Student	• A person enrolled in a BC school. Student populations are calculated by headcount. Students include all adult and school-aged persons who are working toward a certificate of graduation.
Student Entitled to an Individual Education Plan	• A student for whom an Individual Education Plan (IEP) must be designed under the Individual Education Plan order, Ministerial Order 638/95.
