Grade	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>The assigned grade of a student on October 15.</li></ul>
K	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Kindergarten</li></ul>
Number of Students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Student population is calculated by headcount.</li></ul>
Student	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>A person enrolled in a BC school. Student populations are calculated by headcount. Students include all adult and school-aged persons who are working toward a certificate of graduation.</li></ul>
