



APPENDIX A – AMBASSADOR PATHWAYS SCHOLARSHIPS OVERVIEW

PROGRAM DETAILS

The B.C. Ministry of Education provides International Student Ambassador Pathways Scholarships to partially support international students graduating from Grade 12 at a B.C. school and transitioning to a B.C. public post secondary institution (PSI) or a degree program at an authorized private degree-granting institution.

Each award is valued at \$1,250. Schools may request up to two (2) Pathways scholarships. Please note that a school is not guaranteed to receive all scholarships requested. See eligibility criteria and adjudication process below.

Note: Please do not include student personal information (e.g. name, PEN, contact information) with this application. Student details will be submitted at a later date. BCCIE will provide additional information if your school is successful in receiving award funding.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for the Student Ambassador Pathways Scholarship, nominee(s) must:

- be graduating from Grade 12 at a B.C. school and entering a B.C. public post-secondary institution (PSI) or a degree program at an authorized private degree-granting institution (see NOTE below for list of eligible institutions); and
- achieve a high academic standard, including strong English-language ability.

Note: Programs at public PSI and degree programs at authorized private degree-granting institutions in British Columbia are eligible for the Pathways Scholarship. Please consult this [list of eligible institutions and programs](#).

ADJUDICATION PROCESS

Applications will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Regional representation will be considered, depending on the number of applications and availability of award funding.
- Award recipients must meet all eligibility criteria (see above) and application forms must be complete.

AWARD NOTIFICATION AND DISTRIBUTION

- Independent and offshore schools with successful applications will be notified by BCCIE via email.
- BCCIE will provide information regarding award funding distribution at the time of notification.

Application package must be submitted to British Columbia Council for International Education (BCCIE) at bccie@bccie.bc.ca with a subject line reading “**2021-2022 ISAPS Application**” by **October 1, 2021**.
