

Resume Instructions Pathway to Teacher Education Scholarship Application (2023/24) (Instructions only—do not submit this document)

## Instructions for students

Prepare the following information and save it to your computer. When you are ready to submit your Pathway to Teacher Education application online, input the information you prepared where prompted.

- 1. Details for up to seven life or volunteer or work experiences that you believe are relevant to your intended career in K–12 teaching. However, you are not required to provide that many.
  - Start with your most relevant experience and answer the following for each experience (you may use point form in your answers):
    - Start and end dates
    - o Total hours
    - Grades you were in during the experience (submit examples from grades 10–12 only).
    - Where did you gain the experience? Please be specific. (500 max characters)
    - Describe your role and responsibilities. (800 max characters)
    - Explain how you demonstrated one or more key attributes of effective teaching in the experience. (800 max characters)
    - Describe how the experience contributed to your development as a future teacher. (800 max characters)
- Describe any other personal interests, accomplishments, or experiences from grades 10–12 that demonstrate your commitment to and aptitude for a career in K–12 teaching. Only include new information here (i.e., do not repeat information that is already noted in your resume or written statement. (1500 max characters)
