- Appropriate strategy implemented
- Solution is not fully complete (no spaces between bars, no labeling of scale, no title)

Training Paper #5 - Mark:3

- Appropriate strategy implemented
- Solution is not fully complete (no spaces between bars, no labeling of scale)

Training Paper #6 - Mark: 2

- Some evidence of appropriate strategy
- Incorrect solution (scale is incorrect, label incomplete)

Training Paper #7 - Mark: 2

- Appropriate strategy, not carried out far enough
- Information is omitted
- Some labeling, incorrect scale, no spaces, no title, no spaces between bars)

Training Paper #8 - Mark: 2

- Appropriate strategy, not carried out far enough
- Some recording errors (bars touching)
- Information is omitted (scale, title, labeling)

Training Paper #9 - Mark: 2

- Appropriate strategy, implemented incorrectly (scale is incorrect)
- Information is omitted (title, labeling)

Training Paper #10 - Mark: 1

- Major errors in recording
- Omissions in the work
- Work is incomplete

Training Paper #11 - Mark: 1

- Omissions in the work (labeling, title)
- Major errors in the work (incorrect scale)
- Work is incomplete (only two bars)

Training Paper #12 - Mark: 0

- Data is simply recopied
- No apparent understanding of the problem

Training Paper #1 - Mark: 4

- Applies relevant skills accurately
- Appropriate strategies implemented
- Correct solution
- Work is clear, detailed and organized

Training Paper #2 - Mark: 4

- Appropriate strategies implemented
- Correct solution
- Work is clear, detailed and organized

Training Paper #3 - Mark: 3

- Applies relevant skills appropriately
- Appropriate strategy, but incorrect solution (only found 3 combinations)
- Work is generally clear

Training Paper #4 - Mark: 3

- Applies relevant skills appropriately
- Appropriate strategy, but incorrect solution (only found 5 combinations)
- Work is generally clear

Training Paper #5 - Mark:3

- Applies relevant skills appropriately
- Appropriate strategy, but incorrect solution (only found 5 combinations)
- Ignored a condition (no pennies)
- Work is generally clear

Training Paper #6 - Mark: 2

- Appropriate strategy but not carried out far enough (only found 2 combinations)

Training Paper #7 - Mark: 2

- Appropriate strategy but not carried out far enough (only 1 correct solution)
- Some errors

Training Paper #8 - Mark: 2

- Appropriate strategy but not carried out far enough (only 1 solution)
- Strategy does not lead to a correct solution
- Some errors

Training Paper #9 - Mark: 2

- Appropriate strategy, not carried out far enough (only 2 combinations)

Training Paper #10 - Mark: 1

- Does not apply relevant skills
- A start just beyond copying
- Shows little understanding of the problem

Training Paper #11 - Mark: 1

- Major error in calculation
- Appropriate strategy but does not lead to a correct solution (only 30¢)
- A start just beyond copying

Training Paper #12 - Mark: 0

- Solution not related to problem
- Incorrect solution, no work shown
