These mobility diagrams show the number of students who move between institution types and between regions when they switch institutions in the B.C. public post-secondary system.



Loop-back arrows indicate that students switched institutions, but remained within ...

- the same sector (in sector mobility diagram), or
- the same region (in regional mobility diagram).

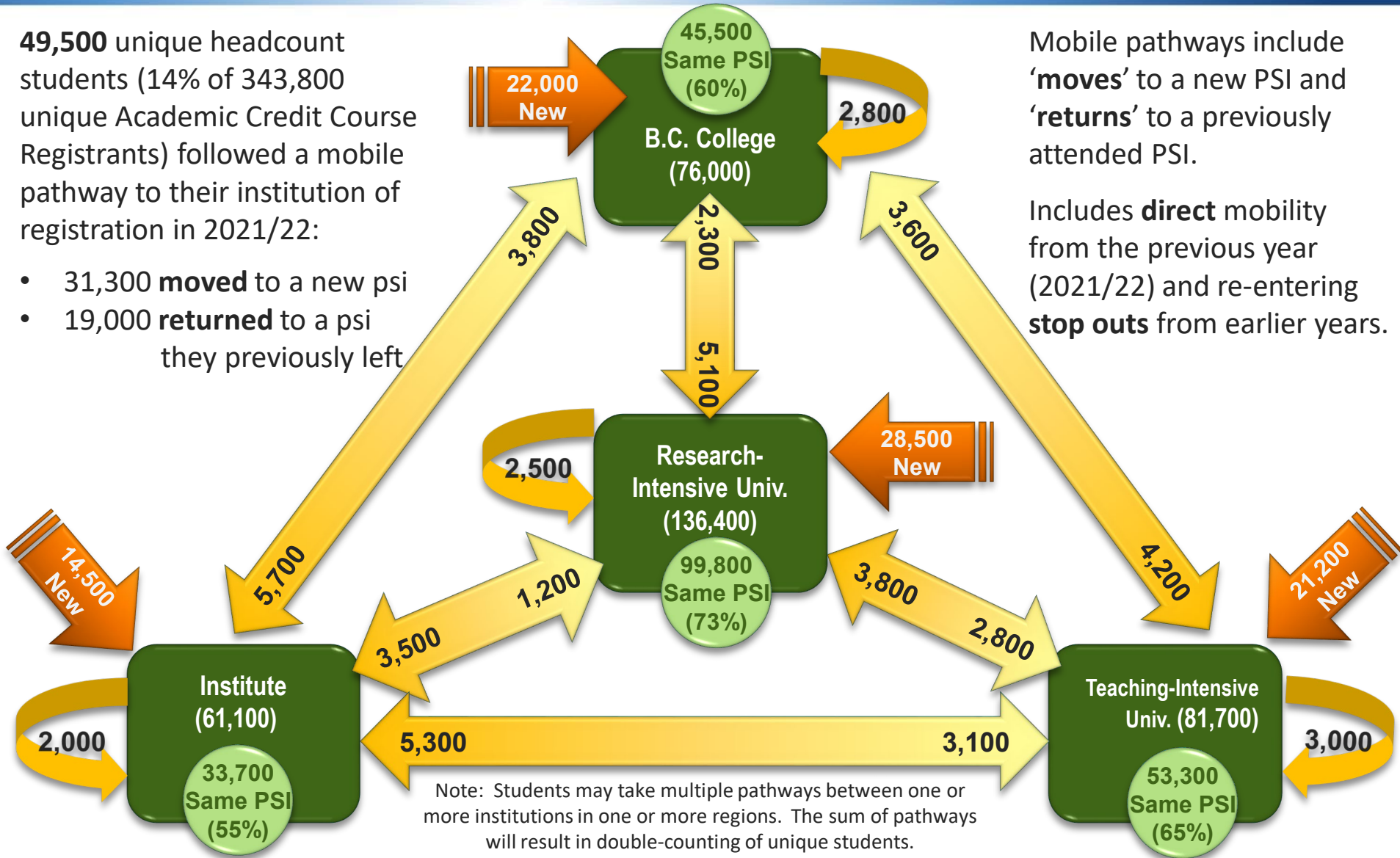
Student Mobility Between Sectors in the BC Public Post-Secondary System (2021/22)

49,500 unique headcount students (14% of 343,800 unique Academic Credit Course Registrants) followed a mobile pathway to their institution of registration in 2021/22:

- 31,300 **moved** to a new psi
- 19,000 **returned** to a psi they previously left

Mobile pathways include 'moves' to a new PSI and 'returns' to a previously attended PSI.

Includes **direct** mobility from the previous year (2021/22) and re-entering **stop outs** from earlier years.



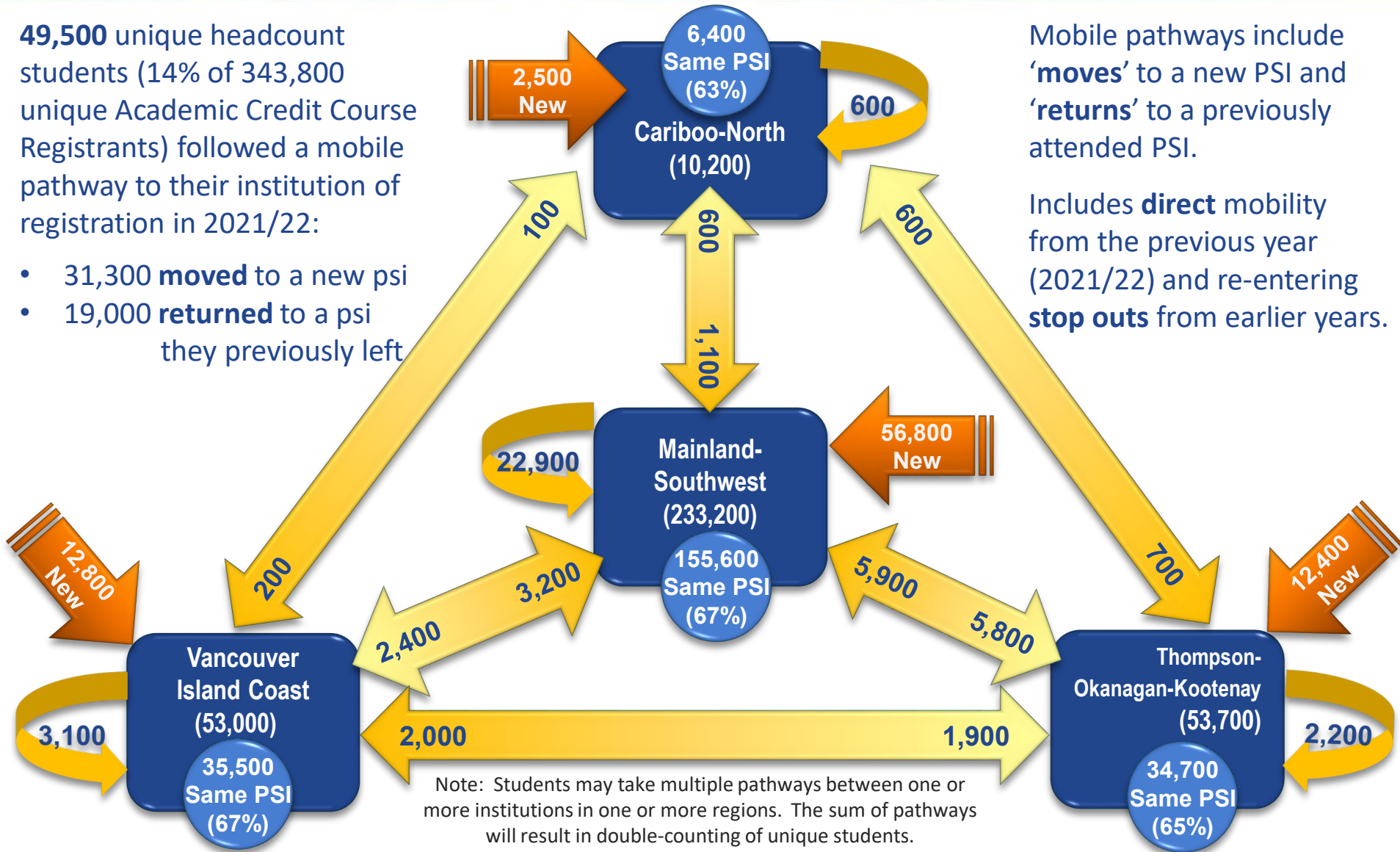
Student Mobility Between Regions in the BC Public Post-Secondary System (2021/22)

49,500 unique headcount students (14% of 343,800 unique Academic Credit Course Registrants) followed a mobile pathway to their institution of registration in 2021/22:

- 31,300 **moved** to a new psi
- 19,000 **returned** to a psi they previously left

Mobile pathways include 'moves' to a new PSI and 'returns' to a previously attended PSI.
