



Dual Dogwood for Francophone Students: Summary of Requirements

Information pertaining to school years 2016/2017 and 2017/2018¹

Francophone students can earn both a British Columbia Certificate of Graduation (Dogwood Diploma) and a Diplôme de fin d'études secondaires en Colombie-Britannique.

In order to graduate with both diplomas and as per the [Graduation Program Order](#), Francophone students are required to earn **a total of 80 credits including:**

- **64** credits in the subject areas set out in the table below, and
- **16** elective credits.

Please note that of these credits, Francophone students must earn:

- at least 16 credits at the Grade 12 level including two Language Arts 12 courses
