

Delegation of Authority
Liquor Control and Licensing Act, S.B.C. 2015, chapter 19,
and Regulations thereunder

In accordance with the authority given to me pursuant to section 5 of the *Liquor Control and Licensing Act* (LCLA), I hereby delegate the powers and duties specified in the sections below to:

1. every peace officer, as defined in the LCLA, and
2. every employee of the Liquor Control and Licensing Branch who is employed in one of the following positions: Inspector, Regional Inspector, Investigator, Regional Manager, Manager of Investigations.

Delegated LCLA powers and duties:

- **Section 42** (authority to request records and conduct inspections)
- **Sections 48(1) and (3)** (authority to temporarily suspend all or part of a licence, authorization or permit for a period not exceeding 24 hours and to order the removal of patrons, persons etc.)
- **Section 50** (authority to cancel a permit or authorization)

This letter rescinds previous delegations issued.

This delegation is effective on and from the date shown below and shall remain in effect until revoked. This delegation may be revoked or amended from time to time.
