Re: Sale and delivery of mixed drinks for off-site consumption with the purchase of a meal for take-out or delivery

Current Policy

Food Primary (FP) and Liquor Primary (LP) licensees are currently not permitted to sell mixed drinks for off-site consumption with the purchase of a meal for take-out/delivery.

New Policy

FP and LP licensees are permitted to package and sell single serving mixed drinks that must contain both liquor and non-liquor ingredients (a cocktail for example) to patrons for off-site consumption with the purchase of a meal.

For specifics regarding non-liquor ingredients, packaging requirements, and the hours in which sale and delivery of liquor for off-site consumption are permitted, see the terms and conditions handbook for your licence type.
