

**SAMPLE OF AN
ASSUMED NAME
UNDERTAKING**

*A foreign entity that has its own name rejected as not available may reserve and adopt an assumed name for use in B.C. In order to complete the registration of an extraprovincial company in B.C. with an assumed name, the **foreign entity must provide** the registrar with a covering letter, attaching the undertaking. See below for sample wording of the undertaking.*

Once the foreign entity is registered it is deemed to have adopted the assumed name.

BUSINESS CORPORATIONS ACT

UNDERTAKING
TO CARRY ON BUSINESS
