


Restaurant Start-up Quick Reference Guide

There are many steps to starting a restaurant in B.C. The following infographic is intended to help you decide when to consider each stage of the process.

Actual timelines may vary by season, region, or municipality: contact your municipality, your regional Health Authority, or the Liquor Control and Licensing Branch to confirm. Ensure you are aware of Employment Standards as set out by the Government of B.C.

After opening, you will be required to collect and remit provincial and/or federal taxes.

Annual renewals are required for your food service permit, business and liquor licenses.
