

STIR Program Q&A @ April 7, 2017

Q: What if we think we can work with the Province to get the project done in less than 16 weeks?

A: We allow 16 weeks to get to an agreed upon product but appreciate some proponents may propose an iterative cycle than can be completed in a shorter time. The education component, including workshops and mentor sessions, is expected to last the duration of the 16 week period. The demonstration day will be a set day in November where all projects can be presented.

Q: Is there potential for a second phase paid contract to begin earlier than the end of the March 31 2018 free trial?

A: Government Business Areas may decide to activate a second phase contract earlier than March 31st. They may choose to activate this if they wish to expand beyond the support and/or functionality of the product developed in phase 1 and addressed in the phase 1 contract. This is at the discretion of the Business Area. All related future contracts will be negotiated between the Government Business Area and the Vendor to the stated annual maximum in the individual Call for Proposal.
