Completing your recovery plan

A recovery plan is a list of specific actions your business can take to support continued operation under the "new normal" conditions of COVID-19. It must be realistic and easy to put in place. It must explain the timeframe for the action to be complete and how much each action will cost.

The recovery plan is a required component of your grant application. You must also provide your direct deposit application at the time of submission.

Submit your information through the <u>document upload webform</u>

Upload information

To upload required information please:

- Go to the document upload webform
- Upload your completed recovery plan
- Fill out direct deposit application
 - Use the <u>direct deposit and banking information instructions</u>
 - Direct deposit application must be completed in full and accompanied by a void cheque or alternate encoded banking document verifying the information provided on the form
 - The business name on your application must match your void cheque or banking document to avoid delays

Submitted recovery plans will be evaluated to ensure it provides a realistic and implementable path to stabilizing your business.

Once the recovery plan is approved, grant funding will be provided.
