3<sup>rd</sup> Intake – Special Circumstances Descriptions**

<b>Applicant</b>	<b>Funding</b>	<b>Project Description</b>
Bella Coola Valley Tourism	\$10,000	This project will provide additional tourist information on Bella Coola through website enhancements, a sign with advertisements/pamphlets at the ferry dock, and a pullout on Highway 20 with information about the valley.
Deka Lake and District Ratepayers Association	\$100,000	This project will clear and widen public access points to four lakes, and create grassed areas away from boat launching to keep boats and swimmers separate. The project is intended to increase lake access and water safety and enhance tourism.
Nuxalk Nation	\$500,000	The project will design and construct a traditional Big House, a cultural path and the 4 Mile Cultural Trail. The Big House is intended to house ceremonial practices and attract visitors interested in Aboriginal culture. The 4 Mile Trail and Cultural Path will provide a scenic route through the community.
Tl'etinqox Government	\$100,000	This project will support the development of a gas bar and convenience store along Highway 18, which will result in a First Nations architecturally, designed facility that operates as a 24 hour self-serve Esso Franchise.
Village of Cache Creek	\$48,000	This project will complete upgrades to the Cache Creek Community Hall to meet industry standards and increase utilization. Project activities will include consulting and designs, building improvements, and lighting/audio equipment upgrades.
