Minimum Wage

All employees in British Columbia are entitled to be paid minimum wage at the rates set out in this factsheet. Minimum wage rates in British Columbia are as follows:

General minimum wage

- September 15, 2016 – \$10.85 per hour;
- September 15, 2017 - \$11.35 per hour.

Liquor servers

- September 15, 2016 – \$9.60 per hour;
- September 15, 2017 - \$10.10 per hour.

Live-in home support workers

- September 15, 2016 – \$108.50 per day or part day worked;
- September 15, 2017 - \$113.50 per day or part day worked.

Live-in camp leaders

- September 15, 2016 – \$86.80 for each day or part day worked;
- September 15, 2017 - \$90.80 for each day or part day worked.

Resident Caretakers

- September 15, 2016 – for an apartment building containing 9 to 60 suites, \$651 per month plus \$26.09 for each suite; and for an apartment building containing more than 60 suites, \$2,217.46 per month;
- September 15, 2017 – for an apartment building containing 9 to 60 suites, \$681 per month plus \$27.29 for each suite; and for an apartment building containing more than 60 suites, \$2,319.65 per month;
