AIR QUALITY ADVISORY ENDED FOR CRANBROOK

(October 28, 2024 11:00 - Cranbrook) The Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Strategy in collaboration with the Interior Health Authority has ended the Air Quality Advisory that was issued October 27, 2024 for Cranbrook due to elevated concentrations of fine particulate matter. Changing meteorological conditions have improved conditions across the region.

- The provincial air quality objective for PM_{2.5} is 25 micrograms per cubic metre (µg/m³), averaged over 24 hours. 24-hour average PM_{2.5} concentrations are summarized below for Cranbrook and other communities at 11:00 MDT today:
