AIR QUALITY ADVISORY ENDED FOR PRINCE GEORGE

(January 29, 2025 7:00 AM) The Ministry of Environment and Parks in collaboration with the Northern Health Authority has ended the Air Quality Advisory that was issued January 27, 2025 for Prince George due to elevated concentrations of fine particulate matter. Changing meteorological conditions have improved conditions across the region.

- The provincial air quality objective for PM_{2.5} is 25 micrograms per cubic metre (µg/m³), averaged over 24 hours. 24-hour average PM_{2.5} concentrations are summarized below for Prince George and nearest monitored communities at 7:00 AM local time today:
